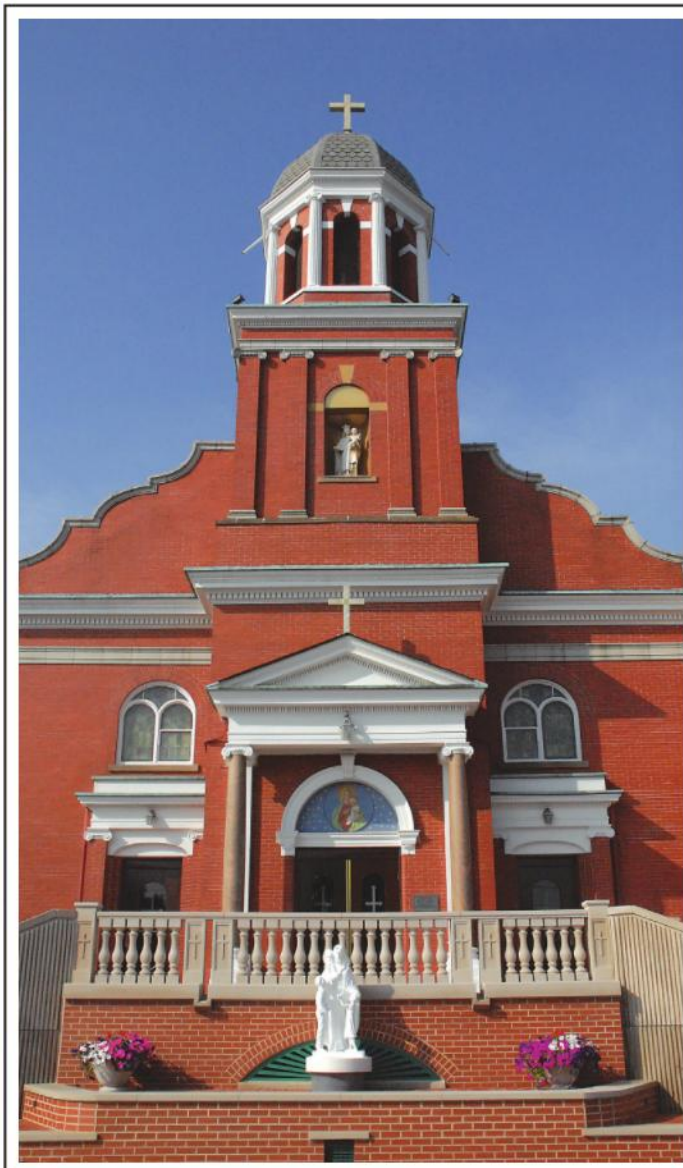

CRAIG'S CORNER

A note from our music director

Even though it doesn't look like it with my skinny figure, I am one to surely enjoy banquets and good food. I eat way more than what shows! Just ask anyone in my family I promise. In scripture today, we hear of a few different banquets.

First in Isaiah, the prophet foretells of a banquet on the mountain where the Lord of Hosts reigns with rich food and choice wines. This is the mountain where death does not exist and where no tears are found. This reading is often used at funerals as we as Christians trust that after our earthly journey is ended, we will be found worthy of this heavenly banquet.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about a banquet for a king's son's wedding. He uses this parable to remind us that while we are all called to His kingdom, it takes much practice and not all people will be chosen. We have to earn our spot.

Paul this weekend tells the people of Philippi in his letter that as someone who has been both starving and full, none of that matters to him because he knows God will supply him with what he needs for the earthly pilgrimage.

We come to our own mountain here at Mount Carmel every time we come to Mass to be nourished by the Eucharistic banquet. This is the food which supplies us with our spiritual nourishment we need to carry out our Christian call to discipleship. This theme is what encompasses our music this weekend. Our opening hymn, "God's Holy Mountain We Ascend" is the perfect summary of us going to God's mountain to worship. God's mountain is where the Eucharist takes place here on earth, but the heavenly banquet is what we want to attain for eternity: where we hope to be the chosen people God invites to enter the dwelling. We reiterate this thought with our communion hymn "Called to the Supper of the Lamb." These are the words in which the priest invites us before we receive the Eucharist each time we come to Mass.

Our call to discipleship is also our invitation to God's banquet. If we follow His way, then we will enjoy the heavenly banquet: where He destroys the veil that veils all people. Then we can, as our psalmist states this weekend, live in the house of the Lord all the days of our lives.

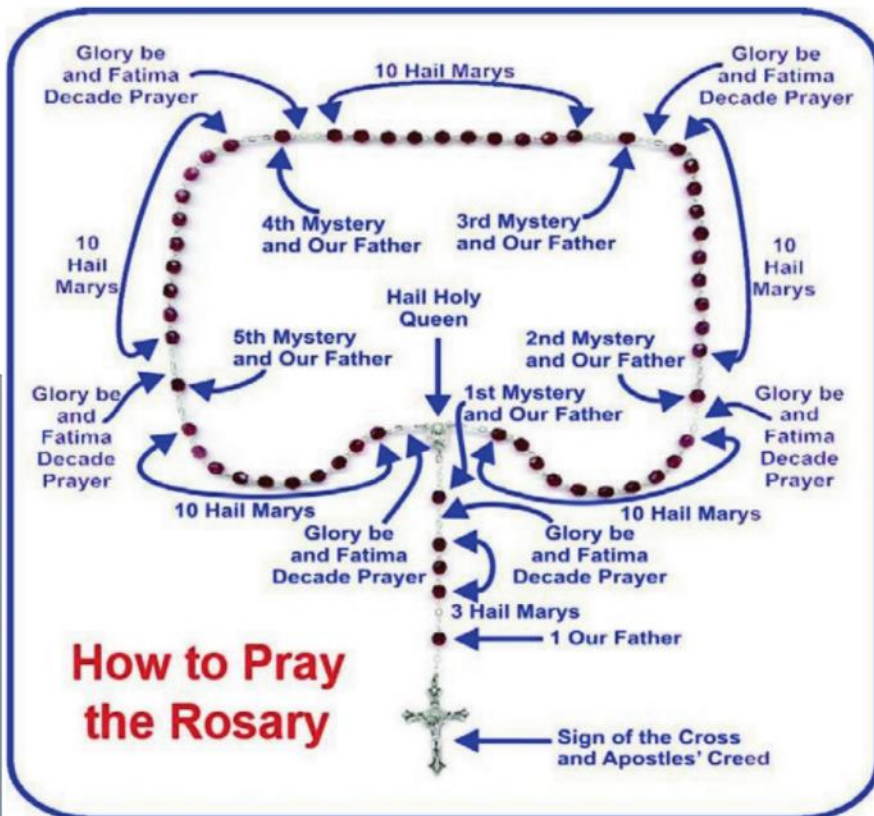
