**TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME  
TODAY'S FOCUS: GOD THE GARDENER**

Even in our largely non-agrarian society, the images of planting, tending, and reaping the benefits of what we've grown is something we understand. All God wants is to reap from us, the vineyard of the Lord.

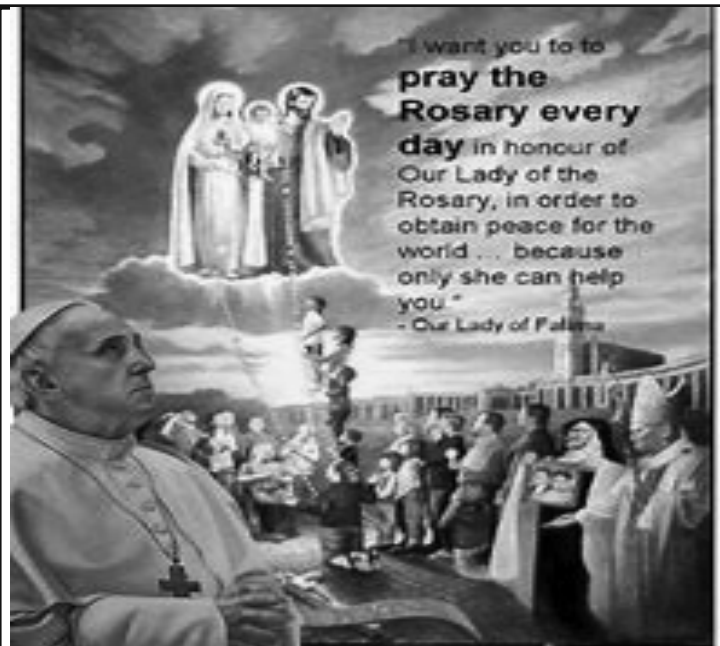
