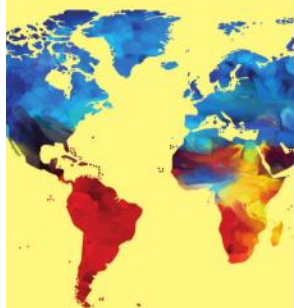

**TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME  
TODAY'S FOCUS: WALKING ON THE EDGE**

Today, as usual, when an attempt is made to trick Jesus into answering a question that seems to have no right answers, he nimbly skips up that precarious edge to point us beyond-and above.

Jesus walks his own "knives Edge" in today's gospel. The Pharisees off two precipices for him to tumble down. There is danger in whichever answer he chooses. To be loyal to the Roman emperor or to God. His words sent them higher, echoing their own psalm: Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.

Psalm 96: 7b  
1 Thessalonians 1: 1-5b  
Matthew 22: 15-21

Lord, the effort to be true to you requires continual effort. Thank you that we do not walk alone. Thank you, Holy Spirit, for the times when you have strengthened our weak knees and redirected our gaze on this hard road of pilgrimage. God of glory, when we see you face to face, the sweat and the struggle will fade away. Sovereign Lord, you alone are our Source and our Summit, for all the earth belongs to you.

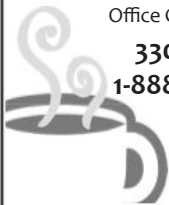
