### TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS: WALKING ON THE EDGE

Today, as usual, when an attempt is made to trick Jesus into answering a question that seems to have no right answers, he nimbly skips up that precarious edge to point us beyond-and above.

Jesus walks his own "knifes Edge" in today's gospel. The Pharisees off two precipices for him to tumble down. There is danger in whichever answer he chooses. To be loyal to the Roman emperor or to God. His words sent them higher, echoing their own psalm: Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.
