



## CRAIG'S CORNER A note from our music director

I often write about the importance of the Psalms in my weekly reflections as our way of praying the same texts Jesus himself prayed. These ancient yet timeless texts not only provide a connection to Christ but are chosen each weekend to be our window into the rest of the scriptures we have opened up before us at Mass.

At my other job, while I strive to put together a perfect forecast every time I broadcast on WKBN or WYTV, education (as it is referred to in school, atmospheric physics), technology and science can only do so much. As perfect as it would be, I can't forecast that a tornado is going to come and wipe out your home at 5:18PM in one week. If I did, you would obviously be able to know exactly when to be in a safe place and you would prepare your home and take your valuable belongings to safety and so on.

I'm reminded of the film *The Bucket List* where the characters do so much stuff they want to do on earth after getting a grim diagnosis. But the point of why I'm bringing this up ties into our Gospel this weekend. Jesus tells the disciples the parable of the virgins and their lamps to teach that we do not know when God's kingdom will come to reign. We don't know when we will be called to our eternal home or when Christ's second coming will be, and so we must be like the wise virgins who had their lamps prepared to greet the bridegroom in Jesus' parable. He tells us to stay awake, for "we do not know the day nor the hour."

The readings of the end of Ordinary Time often focus on the second coming of Christ and the end times. But how are we do stay alert for this kingdom? That's where this weekend's psalm comes in. The psalm states, "My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord; thirsting for you, my God." We, as the psalmist states, must pine for the Lord like a parched earth needs water. By focusing our thoughts, our actions, and our lives upon Christ, we will always be prepared for Him, we won't be caught off guard. This is what he asks of us. If we thirst for Him, and follow His ways, we will have all we need to weather the storm and be prepared when He comes again. This is why our singing of the psalm, not just this weekend, but always, offers a commentary and insight into the theme of the readings of the Mass. This is why also, as I have stated in the past, that I take extra care to prepare the psalms with our cantors to sing them with you.


Let us pray and sing these texts with full hearts, not just another part of the Mass but as an insight to what we are hearing proclaimed each weekend. If we thirst for God and our focus is on Him rather than earthly endeavors, we will be prepared just as we would be if I could pinpoint the exact moment of the tornado strike. This is why Jesus reminds us to stay awake! We do not know the day nor the hour, we must always be focused on Him above all else.





This Sunday's Gospel reading shows us what it means to be truly foolish. We believe in Christ — good! We pray — good! We put time into our faith growth and we value opportunities for more faith formation — very wise! And we say that we trust God — wonderful!

But what happens when God doesn't answer our prayers fast enough? What if we need Christ's loving embrace or his protection from evil and yet we're suffering with no end in sight? Where is Jesus then?

Usually, God's timing is not ours. We think we have the right idea about how soon God should intervene when we ask for his help. Right now is a good time for it, right? Of course! But perhaps not from God's perspective. (Why do we want to leave God in charge anyway, if he doesn't see things our way, huh?)

When we despair over unanswered prayer, the reality behind it is that we're emotionally unprepared for any timing that's different from what we think it should be.

The foolish bridesmaids thought the groom would arrive before their lamps burned out. They thought they understood the situation. Do we? Furthermore, if God's plans are illogical – if they don't make sense to us – we distrust them. And then we get ourselves into the mess of trying to handle things apart from God.



We cannot trust our logic. We cannot trust our perception or our understanding of the situations we're in. The sooner we decide to enjoy the absurdity of being a Christian, the sooner we will find out that God's ways are awesomely much, much better than anything we can imagine!


