**SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT  
TODAY'S FOCUS: THE STATUS UN-QUO**

John the Baptist is surely among scripture's most challenging prophetic figures. To this day he points us to Christ and away from the world's distraction.

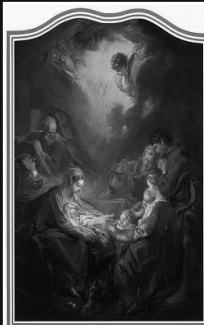

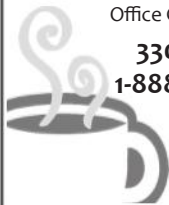
