A PRAYER FOR OUR BISHOP-ELECT REVEREND DAVID J. BONNER



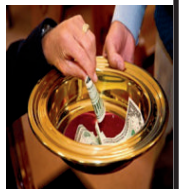

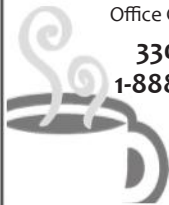
