

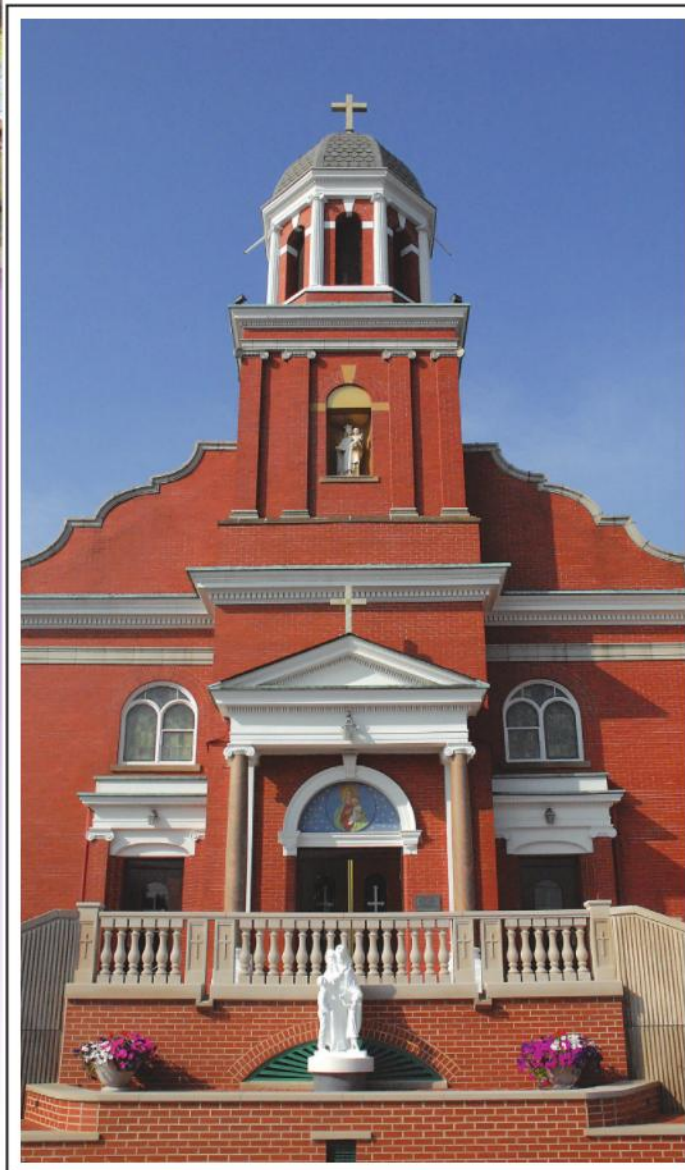

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

Craig's Corner
A note from our Music Director

Trust: it's a word that we hear regularly, and we develop it as we grow in relationships with friends, coworkers and family. Our opening psalm this weekend, Psalm 91, invokes God to be with us in time of trouble for He is the God in whom we trust; He will watch over us and never forsake us. Our Responsorial Psalm reminds us that the words of the Lord are those of everlasting life. As we become closer to God, we should develop even more trust in Him. He is with us in times of trouble, and we should have nothing to fear for He is with us.

In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus once again alludes to His coming death. Jesus foreshadowing his approaching death in the Gospel today will be a continuing theme that we will hear in subsequent Gospels leading up to Holy Week. Let us not only use the music of the Lenten season to bring us to a deeper reverence and prayer, but let it console us and let it spark emotion within us praying that the suffering Christ and His Sorrowful Mother be with us in times of trouble. If we grow in our relationship with Him ever more in this season, we can also grow in our spirituality, knowing that in all of our trials on this Earth, if we trust in God, we know He is there to comfort us. Just as He comforts us, in the Stations of the Cross, so did Veronica show her compassion to Christ. This is the movement of the organ improvisations of the Stations that I have been playing as postludes thus far during Lent. It combines the themes of compassion and redemption as it evokes the kindness shown to Christ by Veronica wiping His face during the steps towards Calvary.

Our offertory hymn this weekend at the 5:00 Mass, "I heard the Voice of Jesus Say," does just that: speaks words of comfort. Jesus tells us to come to Him to find a place of refreshment and peace. The Mass where we celebrate our first scrutiny of RCIA members who are coming into the Church this Easter Vigil hears the Gospel of the woman at the well. This is the basis for the text of the second verse of this hymn: the woman came to the well for a drink and Jesus told her to trust in Him; He is the living water from which all good things come.

Whether we hear the readings of the Year A or B cycle this weekend, depending on which Mass we are attending, we should feel comforted by Jesus' words. Yes, he will die for our sins and thus this season of repentance is upon us. But, when we are brought to new life in the Easter mystery, and are brought from the Cross to the Resurrection, let us trust in Him always to be our stronghold, our rock of salvation: the God in whom we trust.

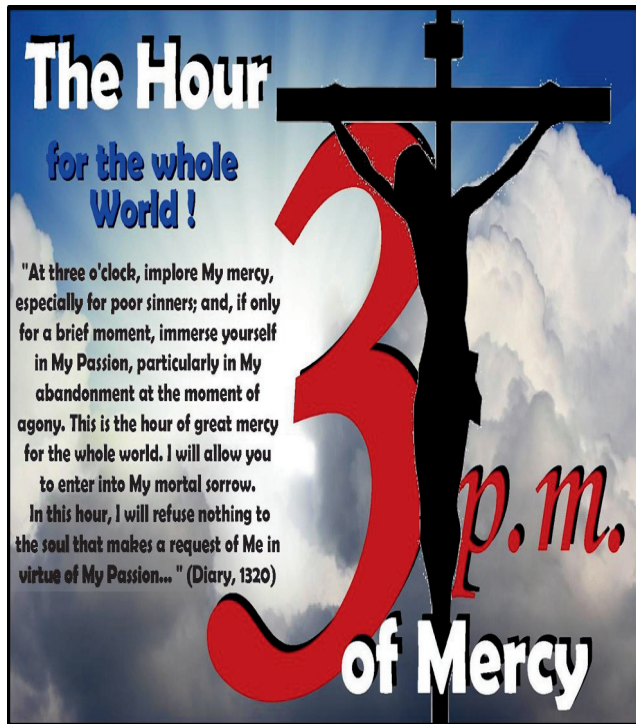

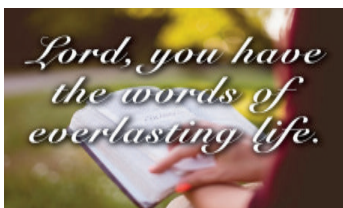
