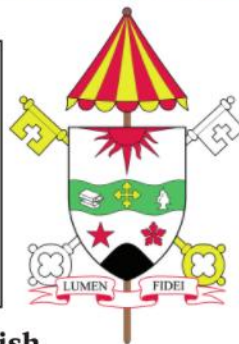

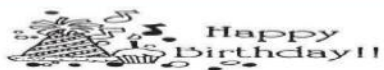

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

Craig's Corner
A note from our Music Director

To many of us, it feels like in the past year especially has been a very tumultuous and dark time. From COVID-19, to political and racial unrest, to even at our own basilica with the recent vandalism of some of our outdoor statues. It's often hard for our human selves to find light in these dark things. From darkness to light: it's a concept that's fairly easy at the surface to think about. But if you really dive into the philosophical sense of what darkness and light is, one such description is this: light is energy of creation, stabilization, rest and peace. Merging energy. Trust, care and love. Feelings. But darkness is also energy. The energy of destruction, destabilization, unrest and war. Fragmenting energy. Fear, hatred and passion. Emotions.

The Church places the theme of light on the fourth Sunday of our Lenten journey as we use the rose color to rejoice, in Latin, Laetare. Saturday's 5PM Mass again contains the cycle A readings as the RCIA class celebrates the second scrutiny while the Sunday Masses hear the B cycle readings. Regardless of which cycle we hear proclaimed at Mass, the theme of light is strong. In the A readings, St. Paul tells us to live as children of the light, not darkness, and we hear the Gospel of Jesus restoring the gift of sight to the blind man so that he can see the light of Christ shine in front of him. In the B readings, Jesus tells Nicodemus that He has come into the world to die for the world because the world is in darkness and sin, in need of light.

Unsurprisingly, our hymns this weekend focus on light. Our opening hymn "Christ be Our Light" calls attention to the injustices and darkness of the world, praying that Christ be the one who brings us to the light, shining in our hearts. Our offertory hymn, "I want to walk as a Child of the Light" proclaims these common themes, reminding us that if we follow the way of Christ, we are not in darkness, for in Him the night and the day are both alike. Our communion refrain prays that as we are fed with the Eucharist, that we receive Christ who is our light when the "shadows of life cloud our view." The postlude this weekend is one of the few movements of the Stations of the Cross I have been playing this Lent in a major and bright key. The eighth station (similar to last week's sixth station of Veronica) is a light in a series of dark pieces as Jesus comforts the women of Jerusalem. While the women feel pity for Jesus while on His path to crucifixion, Jesus pauses for a moment to be a voice of light, a voice of consolation.

This season of Lent is about strengthening our faith by praying that we and the world push away from the energy of darkness: destruction, unrest, war, fear, and hatred and passion and rather focus on the energy of light: creation, rest and peace, trust, care and love, with our eyes aimed at the light of Christ. Let us pray that we continue to move away from darkness to allow the light of the Lord Jesus shine in our hearts.

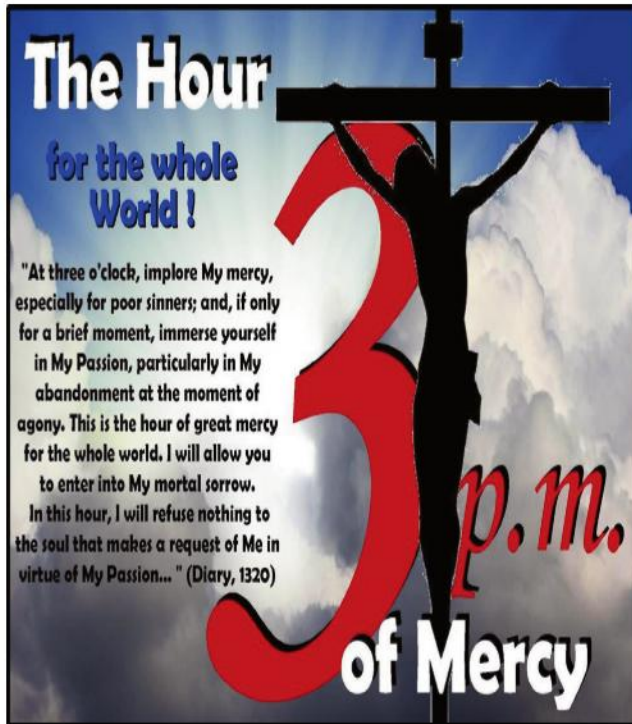
