

#### Craig's Corner A note from our Music Director

#### Witness.

This word comes up a couple times in our readings today. In Peter's statement from the first reading in Acts, he tells the people whom he is trying to bring into the Church that they have all been witnesses of the saving acts of Christ in the recent days. At the conclusion of the Gospel, Jesus himself tells the disciples that they have been witnesses of His suffering, His rising from the dead and that the repentance of sins has been preached through His name. Following the resurrection, the eyes of the disciples were opened to Christ's glorified flesh once he broke bread in front of them and when he ate with them.

Each weekend we are witnesses of the breaking of the bread when we come to the altar and receive Jesus in our communions. So while we rely on the writings of the apostles and evangelists for first-hand witnesses and accounts, we ourselves are the Church today to be witnesses to Christ's message and witness to the sacraments, especially of the breaking of the bread. The priest acts in the person of Christ to transform the bread and wine into the body and blood of Jesus. WE witness this week in and week out! This is why the witness of the Mass is the most important prayer of our Catholic faith. This weekend, we sing the hymn "In the Breaking of the Bread" to commemorate how the disciples also recognized Christ through this sacramental sign. How do we witness our Christian call to others?

The rest of our music this weekend continues our Easter celebration, which we know lasts 50 days up to the feast of Pentecost. This is the last of three straight weekends though that we hear accounts from after the resurrection until we celebrate the Ascension. I once again this weekend want to thank and welcome Alec Ring from St. Peter and Paul Church for taking over the organ bench for the weekend Masses this Third Sunday of Easter while I take some time out of town.






