

#### Craig's Corner A note from our Music Director

Today's fourth Sunday of the Easter season is always referred to as Good Shepherd Sunday since we hear the gospel of Jesus telling His disciples that he is the good shepherd who lays down his life for us, His people and His sheep. He states that He comes to lead those of and those not of His fold. Peter reminds the leaders in our first reading from Acts that they rejected Christ and that through the acts of the cross and resurrection, He saved them too, even though they rejected him. This is why we sing in the psalm that, "the stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone." Christ, whether we affirm it or not, is the cornerstone of our lives. He is the Good Shepherd who laid down His life for us. In our opening hymn "The King of Love," a paraphrase of Psalm 23, we too state that, while we foolishly have strayed from the path at times, in love, Christ our shepherd seeks us out. The text of our offertory solo / choir anthem this weekend, "With a Shepherd's Care," also contains this imagery as the text prays that God nurtures us like parents and when we are lost, that He is our guide.

In the verses leading up to the passage in John's Gospel we hear today. Jesus mentions that His sheep recognize His voice. How does this happen? Because since a shepherd would spend a long amount of time with his herd of sheep, they would recognize his voice more than someone else. The same with us and our relationship with our Good Shepherd: we must spend time with Christ in prayer to truly hear His voice speaking to us. In the communion hymn "Gift of Finest Wheat," the first verse speaks of Christ as the good shepherd, stating that "as when the shepherd calls his sheep, they know and heed his voice; so when you call your family, Lord, we follow and rejoice." This text blends our Good Shepherd Sunday with the celebration of the Eucharist. The celebration of daily and Sunday Masses and our prayer life are so important to our relationship with God. God, through His son Jesus, is present with us in sacrament but also in person: risen from the dead which we celebrate with greater jubilation during this Easter season. This is the same joy with which our Blessed Mother Mary had at the tomb after the resurrection of her son and the joy we sing in our closing hymn, "Be Joyful, Mary, Heavenly Queen." This is the joy we need to keep in our hearts every day as we go forth from our spiritual nourishment at the altar of God.

The importance of the Mass can ever be dulled down or lessened. It is how we stay nourished in our relationship with our shepherd and our guide. It is the greatest prayer, but needs to be combined with personal prayer as well. The readings, prayers, and hymns of the Mass should springboard us into the week ahead. Just as we do with all our friends and family, we stay in constant communication with them to keep our connection, so we must do with our good shepherd, so we can recognize his voice and he can guide us to our eternal pasture of heaven.
