Craig's Corner
A note from our Music Director

“In the celebration of Mass the faithful form a holy people, a people whom God has made his own, a royal priesthood, so that they may give thanks to God and offer the spotless Victim not only through the hands of the priest but also together with him, and so that they may learn to offer themselves.’ This is the basis for the ‘full, conscious and active participation’ of the faithful demanded by the very nature of the Liturgy. Because the gathered liturgical assembly forms one body, each of its members must shun ‘any appearance of individualism or division, keeping before their eyes that they have only one Father in heaven and accordingly are all brothers and sisters to each other.’ Singing is one of the primary ways that the assembly of the faithful participates actively in the Liturgy. The people are encouraged ‘to take part by means of acclamations, responses, psalms, antiphons [and] hymns. . . .’ The musical formation of the assembly must be a continuing concern in order to foster full, conscious, and active participation.”

These words are taken from multiple sources of approved Liturgical documents on Liturgy and music in our celebration of worship. These words highlight to us how important our role of congregation is in Sunday and Liturgical celebrations. We are not mere spectators of the sacred mysteries celebrated on the altar, but rather participants in the celebration we are a part of WITH the priest at the altar.

My goal in the ministry of music which I have been a part of full-time at the basilica now since 2016, is to make sure you, our congregation, can actively participate in the hymns, antiphons, and psalms we sing each Sunday. As I have been mentioning in previous weeks surrounding our central feast of Easter, the Mass is the most perfect prayer we can offer to God. These Church documents guide me in my selection of music which fits the theme of the readings for each Sunday as well as keeping the tradition of our centuries-long faith alive. And this is how I approach the selections of music each weekend and try to attribute this column each weekend to explain how the hymns and music relate to the message of Christ and the Church each weekend with the readings.

This weekend we begin to hear a few weeks in a row of discourses of Christ to the disciples before His passion and resurrection as they prepare to take the words that he has taught them and eventually begin the Church after His ascension. This is the goal of the present-day Church as well, to continue to bring the Good News of Christ to our brothers and sisters. As we sing today and hear of Christ as the vine and we being the branches, we also sing that: “We have been told. . . live in my love with all your hearts, as the Father has loved me, so I have loved you.” Now that we have been told and seen the saving acts of Christ through our Easter mysteries, we are the Church of today: actively participating in our liturgical celebrations and taking the graces we receive at Mass and living them out in our weeks ahead.

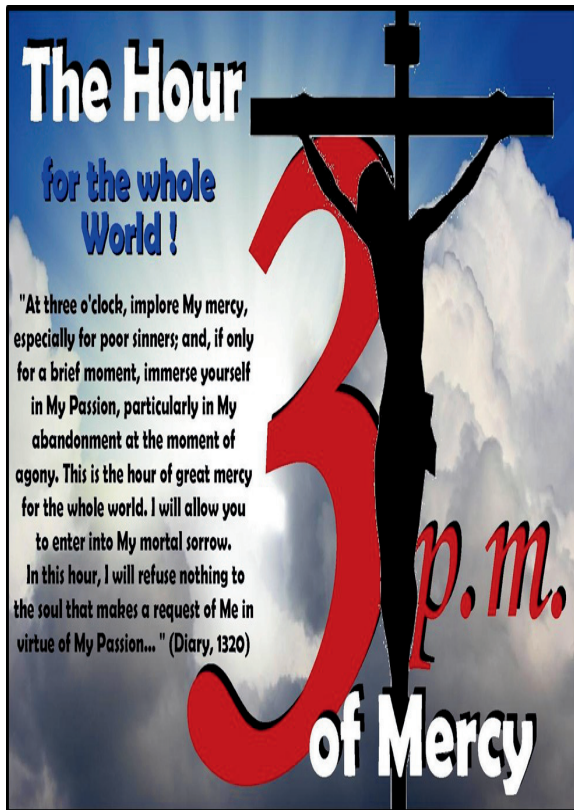

Restrictions have kept us physically apart.

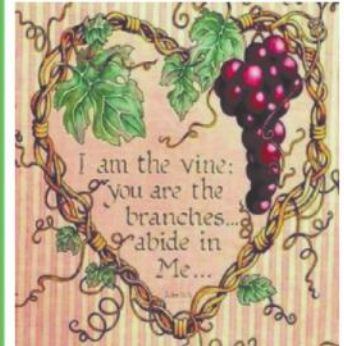
