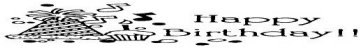

**Craig's Corner
A note from our Music Director**

Last week we were commissioned by Jesus. Just like in every tough task in school or in life, having a tutor or someone to assist us in the endeavor is very beneficial to our mission to accomplish the task. This is what God intended from the beginning of creation and what gives meaning to our lives: living for others. Proclaiming the Gospel and being Christian is definitely no easy task. However, in last week's commissioning by Jesus, we are in fact given that tough task. This is our job as Church and to be Christ to others in what we say and what we do and our tutor and our assistant is the Holy Spirit! That is what we celebrate this weekend. Pentecost Sunday is the birthday of the Church and the conclusion of the Easter season.

This weekend's music asks for the aid and assistance of the Spirit to be brought into our lives as we carry on the mission of the Church. The ancient Church gives us numerous Gregorian chant melodies for the many feasts throughout the year. One of the most common of these chants is the Pentecost chant *Veni Creator Spiritus*. The text of the chant became the common through-composed melody we know of now as the hymn "Come, Holy Ghost." Both this hymn as well as the chant are part of today's Mass. The chant is dispersed among organ verses composed by Nicolas de Grigny which are used for the prelude and the finale for this weekend's postlude. We also sing a couple different adaptations this weekend of the Pentecost psalm #104 where the Spirit is called upon to renew the face of the earth. This also calls upon us to be renewed with the well-known gifts of the Holy Spirit which come to us at our Confirmation. These gifts, too, are our tutors for Christian living.

The offertory solo anthem's text "Come Down, O Love Divine," like most poetry, sometimes takes a few reads to fully grasp the text, which was written by Italian poet Bianco da Siena. The prayer of this hymn is a good text for our Christian lives. It prays that the Spirit comes to seek our human souls, kindling it as a flame burning in our hearts until the passions of the earth are burnt up and instead becomes a glorious light shining in our lives, lighting our paths beyond human knowledge and seeking God's full grace with the Holy Spirit truly dwelling within us.

Come down, O Love divine, seek thou this soul of mine, and visit it with thine own ardor glowing; O Comforter, draw near, within my heart appear, and kindle it, thy holy flame bestowing. O let it freely burn, till earthly passions turn to dust and ashes in its heat consuming; and let thy glorious light shine ever on my sight, and clothe me round, the while my path illuming. And so the yearning strong, with which the soul will long, shall far outpass the power of human telling; for none can guess God's grace, till Love create a place wherein the Holy Spirit makes His dwelling.

This Holy Spirit in us is what gave the disciples the courage to go out, and proclaim the Gospel and begin the Church. And this is the same Spirit which needs to burn in each one of us if we truly want to live out our Christian lives. We can celebrate this birthday of the Church by renewing the gifts of the Spirit within each of us as we go forth and carry on the commission given to us last week, with the assistance of the Spirit to go forth and be the present-day Church to others.

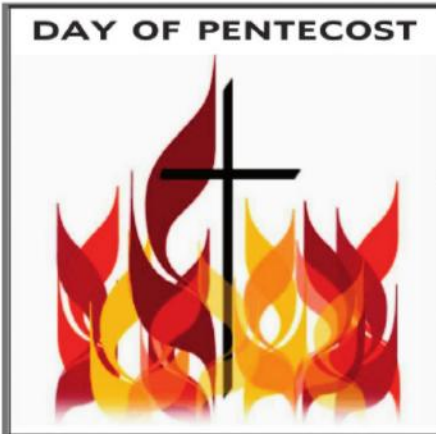

The Holy Spirit is Christ's Spirit generously given to us so that we can be holy and to continue the ministry that Christ began.

On our own, we cannot be like Jesus, but if his Spirit is alive and active within us, we have Christ's holiness, his faith, his supernatural love and peace, confidence and endurance, and everything else that we see in Jesus.

You received the Holy Spirit during your baptism. The reality of this was confirmed and strengthened in the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Ever since the first out-pouring of the Spirit on Pentecost, God has been transforming the world by working through those who serve his Kingdom. He generously fills us with his Spirit so that we will succeed at whatever he asks us to do. But how well his holiness and power exudes from us is up to us.

A Prayer to the Holy Spirit:

Dear Jesus, stir up within me the fullness of Your Spirit.

Help me to live in Your holy power. Open my mind to understand Your truths and my heart to accept Your truths even before I gain right understanding. O Holy Spirit, help me to seek, more than anything, the kingdom of God. Help me to recognize what I am attached to that is not of You, and give me the determination and the strength to let go. I want only You.



O Holy Spirit, help me to face my sins and feel genuine sorrow for the damage that I have caused. Comfort me as I mourn my need for forgiveness, and give me Your spirit of rejoicing over this new growth. Then, help me to share this healing mercy with all those around me.

Jesus commanded, "Go into all the world and preach the good news." Use my gifts and talents to make a difference. I have my own expectations about what I should and should not do. I now surrender to You my ideas, my limitations, my preferences, and my goals. I want to be useful to You. I want to go where You lead me. Holy Spirit, send me forth gifted and empowered to spread the holy and victorious love of Jesus Christ.

Come, Holy Spirit; renew me. Amen!
