**SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME  
TODAY'S FOCUS: SEEING WITH EYES OF AMAZE-  
MENT**

Time and again, Jesus (like his predecessors, the prophets) leads us to the God of the unlikely, the unexpected, the improbable-the impossible! All we need to do is open our eyes.

As we head into a month of Bread of Life discourses, we will see Jesus continually doing the unexpected-feeding five thousand people, walking on water, ducking away from those who would make him king, calling himself the Bread of Life, making his supposed followers grumble at his audacity as they walk away. **SAINT OF THE WEEK  
ST. MARTHA**

Martha, Mary and their brothers Lazarus were evidently close friends of Jesus. He came to their home simply as a welcomed guest, rather than as one celebrating the conversion of a sinner like Zacchaeus or one unceremoniously received by a suspicious Pharisee. The sisters feel free to call on Jesus at their brother's certain death.

No doubt Martha was an active sort of person. On one occasion she prepares the meal for Jesus and possibly his fellow guests and forthrightly state the obvious; All hands should pitch in to help with the dinner.

Martha's great glory is her simple and strong statement of faith in Jesus after her brother's death. "Jesus told her, I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.

Scripture commentators point out that in writing his account of the raising of Lazarus, St. John intends that we should see Martha's words to Mary before raising Lazarus was raised as a summons that every Christian must obey. In her saying "The teacher is here and is asking for you," Jesus is calling every one of us to resurrection now in baptismal faith, forever in sharing his victory over death. And all of us, as well as these three friends, are in our own unique way called to special friendship with him.
