**TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
TODAY'S FOCUS: THE "WE" OF LIFE**

QUEENSHIP OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The mother of a king is a queen who receives honor in her son's realm. Mary is both a queen and a mother, but she is more mother than queen. Mary's Queenship and "motherhood", or motherhood, spark to life simultaneously. In the very moment Mary becomes a mother at the Annunciation, she also becomes a queen. The Archangel Gabriel tells Mary that her Son will sit on "the throne of his ancestor David" and that "He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end" (Lk 1: 32-33)

Mary is that heavenly queen in the mysterious vision of the Book of Revelation in which appears "a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars (Rv 12: 1-3). The complex symbolism of this crowned empress encompasses Mary, Israel, and the Church Herself. Mary's coronation, the Fifth Glorious Mystery of the rosary, has not been defined dogmatically but has been celebrated liturgically and depicted in art since early medieval times. Mary was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen of the universe...

Mary, Queen of the Universe, in your Son's Kingdom, the faithful struggle to be faithful and to be fruitful. We are under your regal yet maternal care. May we please both our King and Father, and you, Our Queen and Mother, since all parents are deserving of their children's honor.

Honor your mother and your father so that you may have a long life in the land of the Lord your God is giving you.
