

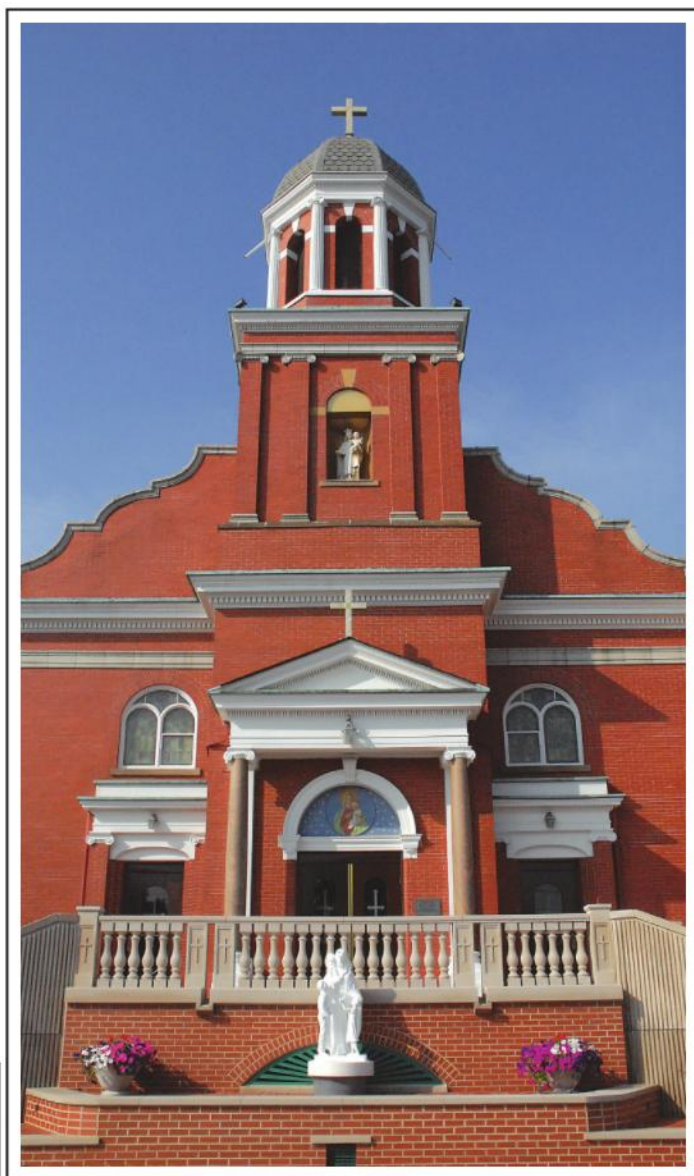

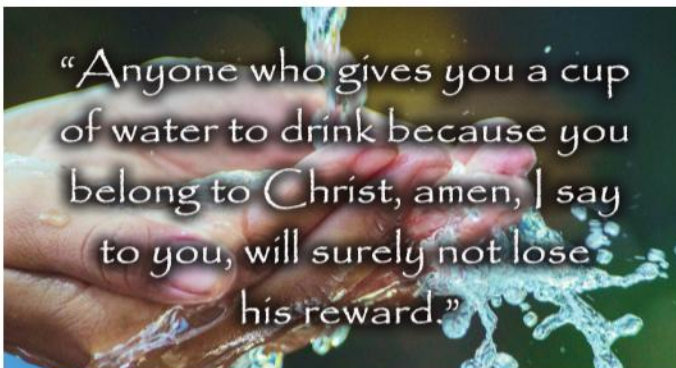

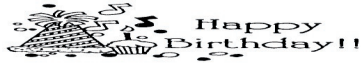

In addition to school and church, Bridget works at Leo's Ristorante in Howland where she is a hostess. In her free time her favorite thing to do is read books.

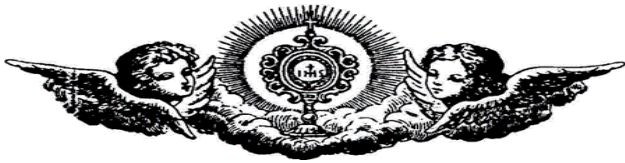
