TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS: GOD PROTECTOR OF LITTLE ONES

One of the main ways in which Jesus was clearly the incarnation of the God of the First Covenant was continual care and concern for the weak, the lowly, the poor, the marginalized, the children-all God's little ones.

A father feels a surge if protectiveness for his pink and wrinkled newborn. The mother of a toddler flies into a rage when she thinks another child will hurt her daughter. A mother bear will attack a hiker who gets close to her cubs. If these are our God-given instincts to protect the helpless, does the Creator also feel a protective rage over the mistreated? Do we dare mess with God's righteous indignation? Might a "hiss" from Jesus make us more careful about how we behave?

Lord, only your are righteous and good. Thank you for the protective instincts that spur us to keep those we love safe. You ask us to watch over your children, for they are precious to you.
