TODAY'S FOCUS: HOPE IN THE MIDST OF TRIALS

In his Letter to the Romans, St. Paul used the image of a woman in labor to describe the hope that is central to the season of Advent: "All creation is groaning in labor pains even until now; and not only that, but...we also groan within ourselves as we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies. SYMBOLS OF ADVENT

The first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the Christian year. Its length varies from 22 to 28 days, starting nearest St. Andrew's Day and encompassing three Sundays ending on Christmas Day. Purple is historically the main color used for Advent because it reflects penitence, fasting, and the color of royalty to welcome the Advent of the King (Jesus Christ). The focus of the entire season is the celebration of the birth of Jesus the Christ in his first advent, and the anticipation of the return of Christ in the second Advent.
