

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS: FENCING WITH GOD

Many scriptural figures try to get God's revelation to work the way they want it to, from Jacob's wrestling with the angel to Mary instructing Jesus at Cana. God wins, but so do we!

Today's reading from John runs on many levels, from the miracle story on the surface, to allusions to the generosity of God at baptism, to the overflowing richness of the heavenly banquet.
