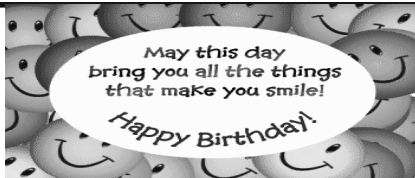

TODAY'S FOCUS: FENCING WITH GOD**
