

Fasting and eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 & not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday & all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.
