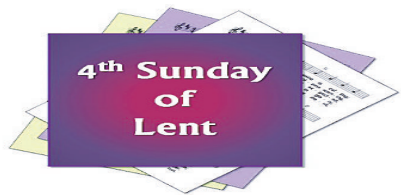

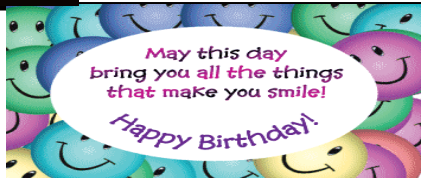

**FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT
TODAY'S FOCUS: THE IMPATIENT,
RUNNING FATHER**

It's a note sometimes overlooked: the father in today's Gospel doesn't stand with his arms folded to receive back his contrite son. Rather, his love makes him run, impatient to embrace his child.

How do we get so bottled up about the pains of earth that we do not see the compassion that surrounds us, the love of the Father who wants us close? What's it like to be the father in this story who wants his sons to be near? How is God like that? How does the prodigal feel to be so welcomed?

Father of compassion, only you know the depths of hurt that family can cause. The pains of earthly life can so bottle us up that we cannot see straight. In this story, sometimes we are the one who wandered away. Sometimes we are the one who drove the other away. Sometimes we are a bit of each, all messed up from things that happened long ago.

Forgive us our bitterness, hates and jealousies. Forgive us our deepest faults this Lent, dear God. Help us to forgive those who have hurt us. Yes, we are broken. Yes, we are sinners. You welcome sinners. You run to meet us. No matter what we have done, you want us to be near. In you, we have our home. No other home can satisfy. Hold us close to you, Lord, and never let us go.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence as Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting & Abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.
