Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday & all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.
