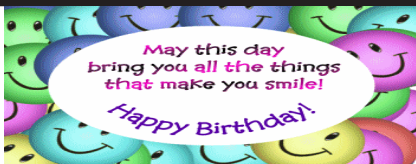

TODAY'S FOCUS: RESURRECTION, IN SPITE OF US**
