

"It is important that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday." The readings on that Sunday are always about mercy, trust and the forgiveness of sins.

The words of Our Lord in the diary are very clear, Jesus said, "I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. By means of the Image I shall be granting many graces to souls; so let every soul have access to it.

(Diary 341, 570) The image should be placed in the church so that everyone can see it, perhaps in the sanctuary area and at all the Masses on that day so that everyone may venerate and know about it and come to trust in the Lord.

Our Lord Jesus said, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet...Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." Then plenary indulgence that was issued for Divine Mercy Sunday does not change the promises of Our Lord. Rather it provides the Church's highest mark of approval and endorsement and gives souls more time to go to Confession.

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER TODAY'S FOCUS: LOCKED DOORS


REGISTRATION:
