

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER TODAY'S FOCUS: CHURCHY WORDS

All words-even holy, sacred words-can suffer from overuse or misuse. When we say we're going to glorify God, it must be with a sense of how much that calls upon us to do. Truly giving glory to God is not to be done lightly.

How empty is a life of devoid of glory! How do we pump the air of experience back into the word glorify so that it extols the richness and grandeur of God? It obviously meant something to Jesus, that he would use the word five times in today's Gospel. Maybe this week, we could set cynicism aside and glorify something by saying, "This is great!" or "He/she is wonderful" or "God is good!" Try it at least once each day. See if it changes the words you say and the air that you breathe.


