Along The WAY

I express my gratitude to Fr. Dennis Veltri of the Diocese of Erie who celebrated the Masses and heard Confession here at Our Lady of Mount Carmel while I was on my annual retreat for 6 days this past week. Fr. Dennis shared with me your warm welcome for him. My retreat this year was the famous "El Camino de Santiago" in Spain. I walked in heat and even rain, the ups and downs on the rocky way for over 35 miles in six days to end up at the Cathedral of St. James in Santiago where the relics of St. James the Apostle are preserved and venerated. For me it was a challenge. Nothing to do with old age! "El Camino" in Spanish means The Way and reminds the pilgrim making the Way that our life is a pilgrimage to Heaven, and also that the pilgrimage is not always easy.

Let me share with you one experience that I had on the "El Camino" or The Way. As a pilgrim I visited a beautiful Basilica called Our Lady of the Oak, referring to our Lady carved from a huge Oak tree. While there, a priest approached to welcome me and my three fellow pilgrims, my goddaughter Michelle, her husband Francis, and his mother Endemena. He was the Rector of the Basilica. I shared with him that I was the Rector of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica in Youngstown, Ohio, USA. Immediately he turned all the lights on in the Basilica and gave us a magnificent tour of its awesome beauty. Then he pointed to a side altar and said, *mira, mira, look, look*. Above the altar was a hand carved statue of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. I thought I was back home. I was so pleased, and he noted it as he smiled at me and nodded his head saying, si, si, yes, yes. I knew then that he knew the importance of Our Lady of Mount Carmel for our spiritual life. Amen.



The Pending Dobbs Decision - How is a Catholic to Respond?


