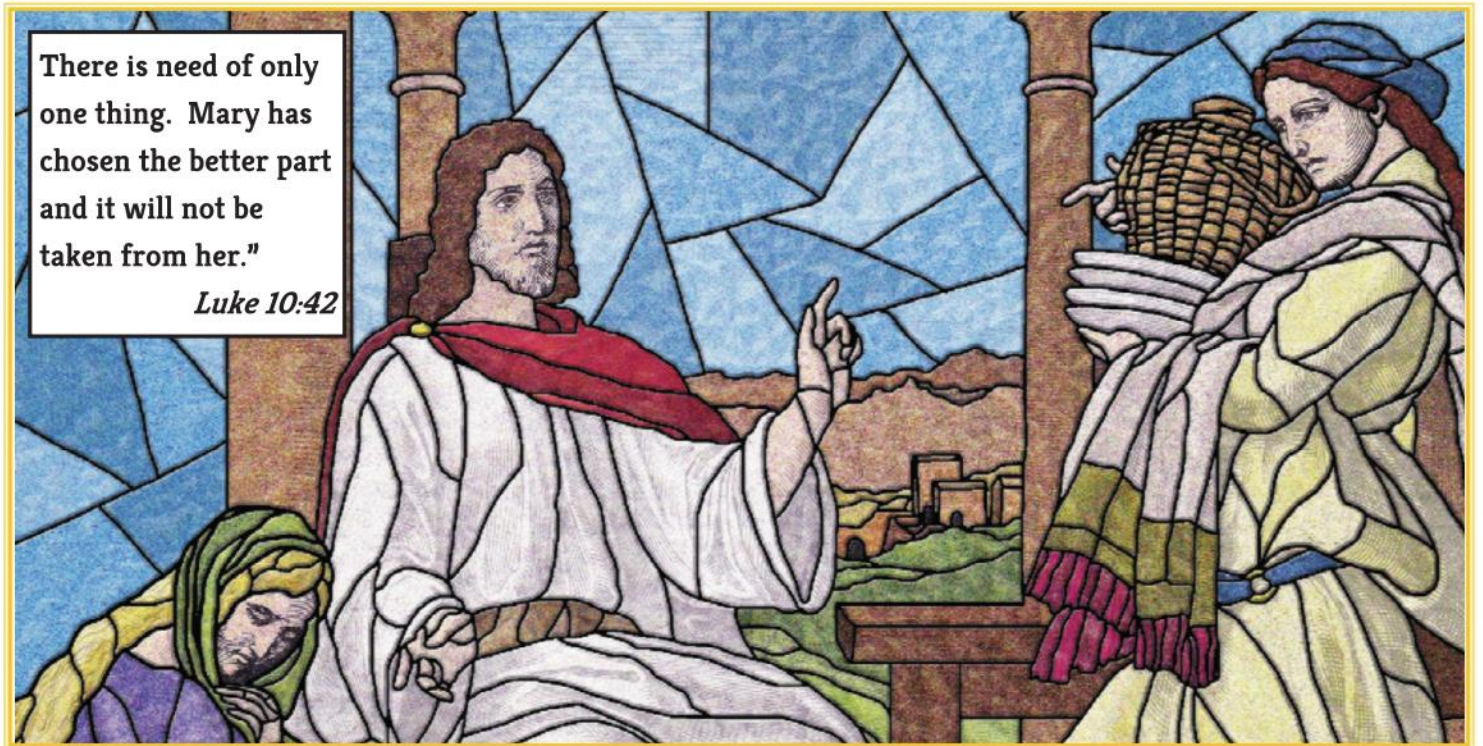




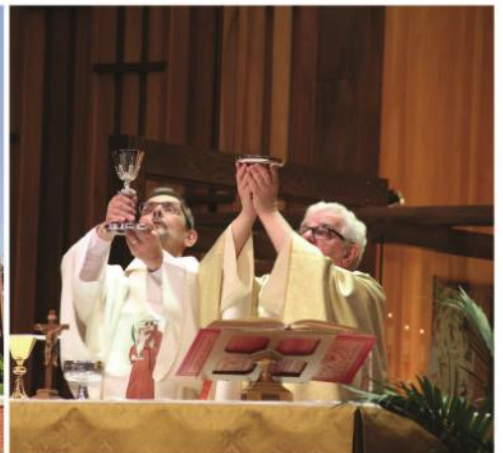

## Along the WAY

"Oh, he is nothing but a do-gooder." I have heard people talk that way about others; probably meaning that he does all those good things in order to be seen. That remark, however, can take away from the importance of reaching out to others and even take away from the true meaning of the Good Samaritan parable.

As Catholics, we believe that we are saved by the Precious Blood of Jesus and the Holy Wood of the Cross. Our good works show Jesus that we believe in Him, and that we know that each of us must be a Good Samaritan to get to heaven. Nothing less!

One Good Samaritan story: a family of six from Ohio took an adventurous ride to Alaska in August. Their Winnebago broke an axle in the middle of wild country. The dad walked to a farm where he found the owner. The owner, not knowing the family, got out his tools and welder and after hours of hard work, fixed the recreational vehicle. How grateful the family was! The trip could have been a disaster. "How much do I owe you?" the father asked the farmer. "Nothing," the farmer replied. "It was nice to have all six of you here for the day. You made my day."

Who is the Good Samaritan? He is my neighbor - any one in genuine need.

Learn the true meaning of the parable about the Good Samaritan. Our faith in Jesus, who saves us, helps us recognize that anyone who is in genuine need is our neighbor. That is one of our tickets to Heaven.

## OUR LADY of MOUNT CARMEL

### What is the Story of Our Lady of Mount Carmel?

Mount Carmel has been a place of prayer and closeness to God since the time of the prophet Elijah in the 10th century before Christ (cf. 1 Kings 18:41ff). There, also, Christian hermits persisted in prayer. And there, in the 12th century, the Order of the Brothers of the Blessed Virgin of Mt. Carmel were officially founded.

The 13th century was a time of persecution for the Carmelites, and, in the midst of this trial, on July 16, 1251 the Blessed Virgin appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Prior of the Carmelites, giving him the Brown Scapular. She said to him, "This is a privilege for you and the order: whoever dies wearing the Scapular will be saved."

The wearing by others of a miniature version of the Carmelite Scapular, known simply as "the Brown Scapular" from the color of their habit, has come to mean being joined spiritually with them in accepting the Blessed Mother's love, devoting oneself to the spirituality of the Carmelites, and trusting that Our Lady will protect them in life and at their death.

Any Catholic with the right intentions may be enrolled in the Brown Scapular. The Scapular should be worn as a sign of love for Jesus and allegiance to Him. It likewise indicates a willingness to follow the example of His Mother, entrusting our protection to her care. When we truly love the Lord and Our Lady, and live out our faith in a virtuous way, we can be assured of the promises associated with the Scapular. On the other hand, the Scapular should never be worn as a good luck charm, nor as an assurance of avoiding purgatory or hell whatever our behavior. To do so would be superstitious and therefore in vain.
