### Along the WAY

As we go Along the Way, I share with you the results of the Annual Diocesan Appeal for the needs of Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Youngstown and Diocesan Ministries. The Diocese assessed our parish for \$76,700 and we raised \$90,710! In total, 232 households generously contributed to this amount, and we are grateful! I wholeheartedly thank all who generously contributed in these challenging times. It is clear that this past year has affected our parish and community. Last year, our parish raised \$95,575 for the Annual Diocesan Appeal, with 310 households contributing, and despite the fact that we raised more than was asked, the Diocese of Youngstown was unable to reach its annual appeal goal of \$4,000,000. God's choicest blessing upon all who made their sacrificial offerings. If you were unable to do so this year, I understand.

On Monday, July 25, the altar servers went to the Scrappers game, along with some adults. There were twenty-seven of us and a good time was had by all. We were all Scrappers fans and we won big time! A great game! Thank you altar servers for your fidelity and tenacity. What a privilege it is to serve both at the Altar of the Holy Eucharist and serve the Lord by the way you live.

This week, our Parish Council met, looking forward to a new academic year. Pray for the Council. May our work be fruitful for the care of souls and our homes.

Just a final note, as I conclude, and that is to advocate for the Catholic Schools. As a parish we help support families with the cost of tuition. If you have children that attend a Catholic school, and would like assistance, please call the rectory for more information.

### August - Month of the Immaculate Heart

The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tuy, in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart.



On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate Heart. Let us remember this devotion year-round, but particularly through the month of August.
