Along the WAY

As we go Along the Way, I was present at the Greater Youngstown Italian Fest for the special award of the Italian Woman of the Year given to Cathy Zack from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica. Cathy is grateful for her Catholic Faith, her Italian-American ancestry, her family, and her parish community. Cathy was honored in 2016 when she was named the Italian Woman of the Year at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel's Festival. A double header! How very well deserved!



Recently, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel received the gift of an eighteen-foot marble statue of Christopher Columbus from Columbus State Community College. It has now been placed in the bocce court area of the ground and will enhance the historic memory of Christopher Columbus together with the work and ministry of the Knights of Columbus in their Catholic witness. I am putting together a booklet containing further descriptions of this gift, which will be formally dedicated on October 12, 2022 during our Columbus Day Celebration.

This past Wednesday, I led the Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Our Lady of Consolation Basilica Shrine in Carey, OH. Thirty-three pilgrims prayed for the vocation to the priesthood and religious life. Once again, lots of prayers from us to Our Lady - which are always heard! The pilgrimage was a lot of fun, believe it or not, and very peaceful. Our Lady of Consolation, pray for us.

Our Lady of the Arctic Snows

On August 5, Sir Knight Beri Berardi of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel brought to the Basilica the canvas painting of Our Lady of the Arctic Snows, in commemoration of the Dedication of St. Mary Major Basilica in Rome on August 5. In 431, following the Council of Ephesus which affirmed Mary's title as the Mother of God, Pope Sixtus III rededicated St. Mary Major as the largest church in the world honoring God through Mary. The Basilica stands at the top of one of Rome's seven hills, the Esquiline, where a miraculous summer snowfall is believed to have taken place on August 5, 352. According to that story, a wealthy Roman couple, unable to have children, pledged their fortune to the Mother of God, and as a response, Our Lady produced



the snowfall and, in a vision, told them to build a church on that site. The Pope at the time, Liberius, had the same dream. Rising immediately, he went to the spot, and found the couple kneeling in prayer in the snow. Hence, Mary is also celebrated under the title of Our Lady of the Snows on August 5. This event was long celebrated in Rome by the release of a shower of white rose petals from St. Mary Major Basilica's dome every August 5.

This particular image of Our Lady of the Arctic Snows commemorates her Alaskan home. It was commissioned by Fr. Edmund A. Anable, S.J. in 1953, who wanted to obtain a picture of Mary that the Native women of the North could identify with. The Belgium artist, Robert Van Hove, painted the image, completing it in 1957. The copy that was present in our parish community this past weekend is the only framed version of its size in the lower 48 states.




