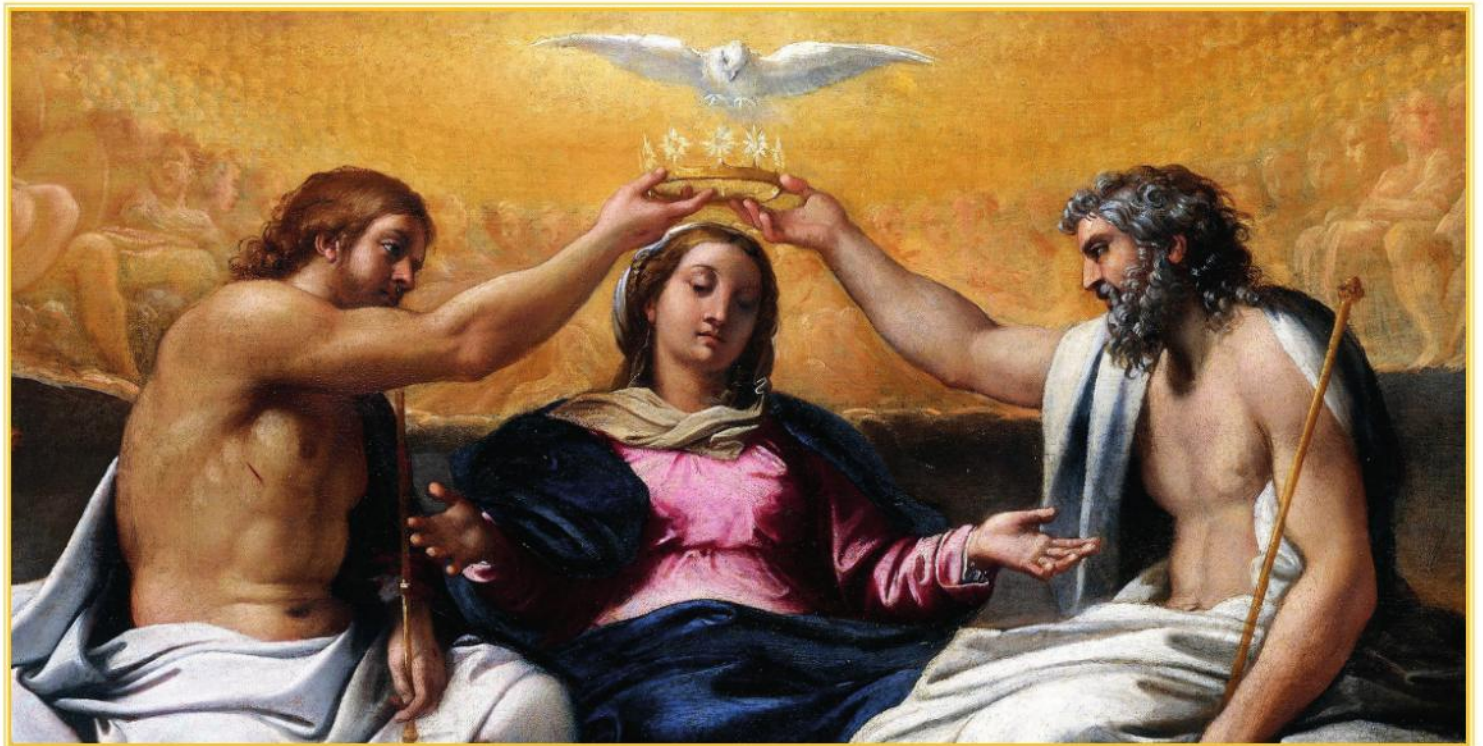


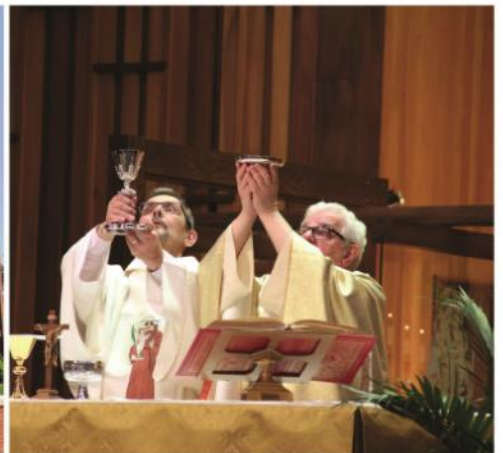

I want to begin by thanking Deacon Anthony and Sister Kristen for joining us last Wednesday on the diocesan annual pilgrimage to Our Lady of Consolation Basilica Shrine in Carey, Ohio on Wednesday, August 10. It was a peaceful and graced-filled day.

The Historic Smoky Hollow has begun a small but precious festival to honor Our Lady's Assumption into Heaven, Body and Soul. The inaugural event took place on Saturday, August 13, and at 5:30 PM there was a procession of Our Lady and a blessing of the families gathered. The procession was followed by nice music and excellent Italian foods with vino and soft drinks. *Evviva Maria!* According to the historian for the Hollow, there were over 150 persons present.

This past Monday, August 15, was the Solemnity of the Assumption, where we honored Mary who was assumed Body and Soul into Heaven when her earthly journey was complete. She is a great sign of hope for us all. We ask her to help us in our journey with Jesus so we can be part of the great Communion of Saints when our own journey is complete. Although the holy day of obligation was dispensed by our Bishop, the noon Solemnity Mass at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica was very well attended. At St. Anthony Church, Mass was offered by Bishop Bonnar at 4pm on the occasion of the perpetual vows of Sister Blanche of the Oblate Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. A beautiful celebration! The Reception of Holy Communion at Mass

PART 1

The Church understands the Communion Procession, in fact every procession in liturgy, as a sign of the pilgrim Church, the body of those who believe in Christ, on their way to the Heavenly Jerusalem. All our lives we who believe in Christ are moving in time toward that moment when we will be taken by death from this world and enter into the joy of the Lord in the eternal Kingdom He has prepared for us.

The liturgical assembly of the baptized that comes together for the celebration of the Eucharist is a witness to, a manifestation of, the pilgrim Church. When we move in procession, particularly the procession to receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion, we are a sign, a symbol of that pilgrim Church "on the way."

The Communion Procession is an action of the Body of Christ. At Christ's invitation, extended by the priest acting in Christ's person, we hear at Mass, "*Blessed are those who are called to the supper of the Lamb.*" The members of the community move forward to share in the sacred meal, to receive the Body and Blood of Christ which is the sign and the source of their unity. In fact, each time we move forward together to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord, we join the countless ranks of all the baptized who have gone



before us: our loved ones, the canonized and uncanonized saints down through the ages, who at their time in history formed a part of this mighty stream of believers.
