

The Reception of Holy Communion at Mass

The Communion Procession, an action by Christ's body, the Church assembled for the Eucharist, is manifested and supported by the Communion Hymn. This is a hymn in praise of Christ sung by the united voices of those who believe in him and share his life.

The Communion Hymn is prayer, the corporate thanksgiving prayer of the members of Christ's Body, united with one another. When we come together to participate in the Eucharistic celebration we come, not as individuals, but as united members of Christ's body.

In each of the Eucharistic Prayers God is asked to send his Holy Spirit to make us one body, one spirit in Christ. The function of the Communion Hymn is to express outwardly the communicants' union in spirit by means of the unity of their voices, ... and to highlight the "communitarian" nature of the procession to receive Communion. (GIRM #86). We recall Christ's words at the Last Supper, where he pleaded with his Father: Holy Father, keep those you have given me true to your name, so that they may be one like us ... Father, may they be one in us, as you are in me and I am in you... (In 17:11; 21). Baptism has joined us to Christ and to one another as the vine and its branches. The life of Christ, the Holy Spirit, enlivens each of us individually and all of us corporately, to guide us in our efforts to become one in Christ.



This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish. Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.
