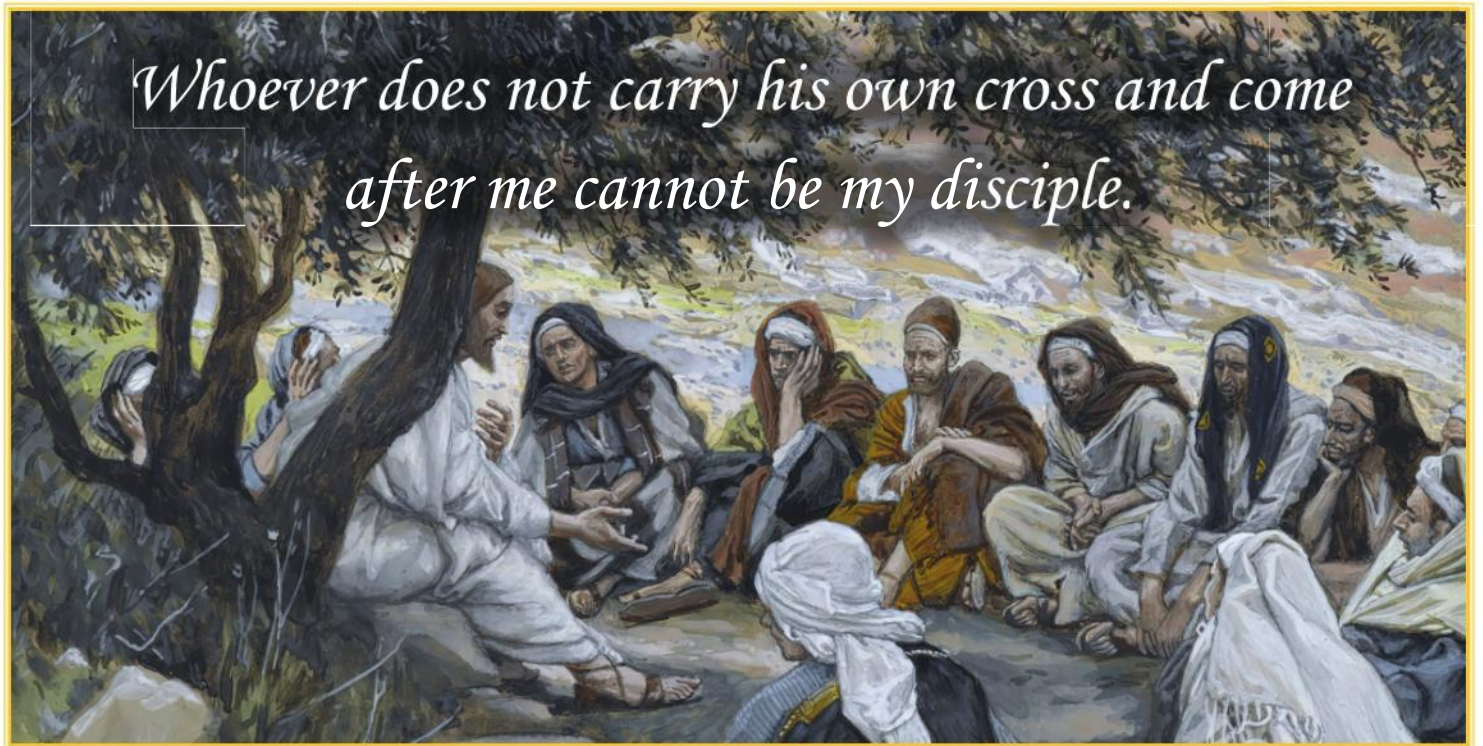
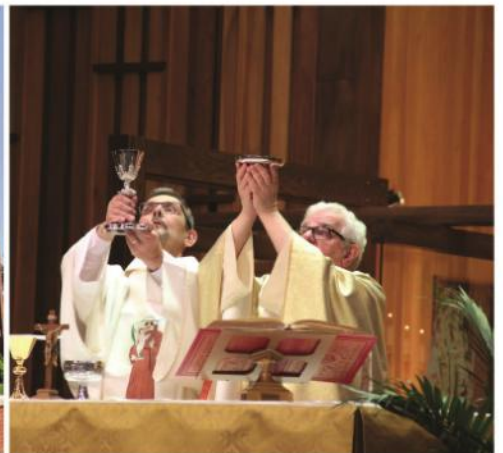

As I go Along the Way as your Pastor, there are many steps that are taken which the average parishioner may not always notice. There is the obligation to pray each day the Liturgy of the Hours over and above the celebration of daily Mass. There are the ongoing Pre-Cana meetings with couples seeking marriage in our Church. There are the sick calls to the members of the parish who are seriously ill and these often happen at a moment's notice and are always appreciated by the families. The Reception of Holy Communion at Mass

PART 3

Gestures of homage and reverence for the Body of Christ are as old as the magi we hear about in the Christmas story. That is what St. John Chrysostom, the "Golden-Mouthed" bishop of Constantinople, told his congregation 1600 years ago: *"The wise men paid homage to Christ's Body when it was lying in the manger."* But he reminded his hearers that, *"Unlike the wise men, you do not merely see Christ's Body; you know his power as well, and the whole divine plan for our salvation . . . Let us then awaken in ourselves a feeling of awe, and let us show a far greater reverence than did those foreigners. . ."*

The Church has constantly desired a deep reverence on the part of all who receive Jesus Christ in Holy Communion. While the outward gestures by which inner reverence has been expressed has differed over the years, one thing remains changeless: **our reverence and care in receiving the Lord Jesus in this holy sacrament.**



The United States bishops have directed us in that *"when receiving Holy Communion, the communicant bows his or her head before the Sacrament as a gesture of reverence and receives the Body of the Lord from the minister. When Holy Communion is received under both kinds, the sign of reverence is also made before receiving the Precious Blood."* (GIRM #160).

The **"reverent gesture"** is not simply a nod of the head but an unhurried bow of the head. Through our bow of the head we profess our faith in the Eucharistic presence of Christ, and express our reverence.
