

Along the WAY

While I go along the way each week as your Pastor, I also serve the Diocese in the Tribunal Office, which is primarily committed to assisting the faithful in promoting the sanctity of marriage through helping couples who desire to have their marriage blessed by Christ and the Church. Often this may require a petition for matrimonial nullity of a previous union or sometimes documentary evidence that the previous union was not ever recognized by the Church. I think you understand that especially today we need to do all that we can to uphold the sanctity of marriage and the family. We should always promote the family and marriage before Christ and the Church without counting the costs.

Recently a family from the parish came forward to do whatever it took to get their blended family back on track with Christ and the Church. It took a lot of courage on their part, but I think all their efforts will be fruitful. Please keep the family in your prayers.

This past week I have been working with a committee for the promotion of a basic and well-grounded safe environment for our people who gather here for the Liturgy, Sacraments, and community events. The Safety Committee is well formed and making sure we have on hand good first aid supplies, AEDs, and security, so you can always have that sense of security when we gather together.

I trust you all had a good Labor Day. Let us pray to St. Joseph the Worker, that we may see the eternal value of our daily work and that we may perform our work with thankfulness and joy. Let us also pray for our students.

The Reception of Holy Communion at Mass PART 4

The most basic meaning and valid definition of the word Amen is So be it. Amen is a word that expresses our assent to what has preceded it. Scholars tell us that the root word in early Hebrew from which Amen is derived meant "to pound in one's tent stake." Recall that when the Hebrew people were wandering in the desert, a tent was necessary to shield them from the heat of the midday sun and from the cold of the desert night. Thus this phrase and meaning sounds a lot like our expression, "I'd stake my life on it."

Think of all the times we say Amen during Mass. Our most significant Amen comes at the end of the Eucharistic Prayer and at the reception of Communion. In different ways, these Amens express our willingness to join ourselves with Christ and embrace his sacrifice.

When we sing Amen at the end of the Eucharistic Prayer, we are proclaiming that we will stake our life on the Paschal Mystery, that we are willing to die to self in order to rise to new life, and that we will accept whatever comes from following the Father's will as Jesus did.



Likewise at Communion, we say Amen when we receive the Body and Blood of the Lord. By saying Amen, we accept the Body of Christ broken for us and the Blood of Christ poured out for us. We recognize that we are part of the Body of Christ who share this communion together. We express our willingness to become the Body of Christ in the world today; to pour out our lives for the sake of others. Thus the only proper response to the reception of Holy Communion is always AMEN!
