





# **CRISIS IN MARRIAGE**

Te often think of the "vocations crisis" as referring to the decreasing numbers of priests and religious, but the vocation of marriage is faring far worse. In the last fifty years, the number of annual priestly ordinations dropped 54%, from 805 ordinations in 1970 to 441 in 2021. In that same time period, the annual number of Catholic weddings dropped by more than three-quarters: there were 77% fewer newlyweds last year than there were in 1970. And this while the Catholic population grew by 20 million people. Thus while we teach Catholic youth to listen for God's call, we need to be sure to emphasize that Christian marriage, while at times difficult, is a beautiful and worthwhile vocation.


