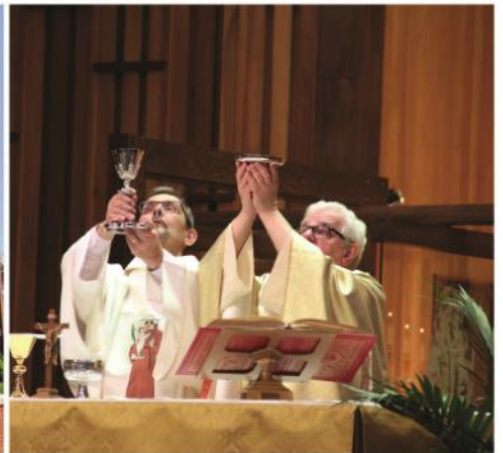

## Pope Francis on All Souls’ Day: Do you desire heaven above everything else?



On All Souls’ Day, November 2, 2022, Pope Francis urged Christians not to “compromise with the Gospel” but to take Jesus’ words seriously when he says we will be judged by how we treat the poor. “Often, out of convenience or comfort, we tend to tone down Jesus’ message, to water down his words. Let’s face it, we have gotten pretty good at compromising with the Gospel.”

“From simple disciples of the Master we become masters of complexity, who argue a lot and do little, who seek answers more in front of the computer than in front of the Crucifix, on the internet rather than in the eyes of our brothers and sisters; Christians who comment, debate, and expound theories but do not know even a poor person by name, have not visited a sick person for months, have never fed or dressed someone, have never made friends with someone in need,” he said.

In his homily, the pope reflected on Jesus’ words in the Gospel of Matthew: “For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.” The pope said that these words in the Gospel help prepare for death and the final judgment. God is “waiting for us among the poor and wounded of the world.”

“The best careers, the greatest achievements, the most prestigious titles and awards, the accumulated wealth and earthly gains, all will vanish in an instant, everything,” he said. All Souls’ Day is a good occasion to ask “if our desires have anything to do with heaven.”

Ever since the 1992 World Youth Day in Denver, where a crowd of 100,000 chanted "JPPII, we love you!" Catholic youth events have been growing stronger, as evidenced by the thousands who attended Steubenville Conferences this past summer at 16 locations nationwide.

One of the most memorable moments of the conferences comes at the final Mass, when celebrants ask teens to come forward if they're open to a call to the priesthood or religious life. "Every year it's a shock to see hundreds of teens stand up," said Bryan Wells, one of the conference coordinators. "Our mission is to help kids encounter Christ, and one of the fruits is

that they're willing to consider a radical way of life and admit in public." Typically the response to their generosity is overwhelming. "When the teens come forward, the applause literally lasts for minutes," said Bryan. "It's an amazing testament to what the Lord is doing in the Church today."

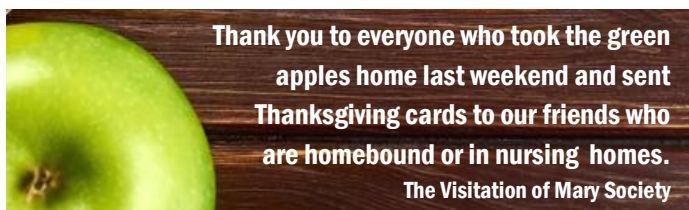
