

# Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception December 8, 2022

### Immacolata Icon

On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, the Knights of Columbus Immacolata Youngstown Council #274 presented Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica with the Immacolata Icon.

The Immacolata Icon was commissioned by a member of the Knights of Columbus upon the beatification of Blessed Michael McGivney on October 30, 2020. The icon depicts Our Lady's apparition to St. Bernadette in 1858, when she revealed to St. Bernadette her unique vocation as the Immaculate Conception. Bl. Pope Pius IX, who declared the Dogma of the Immaculate Conception in 1854, stands on the left side of the icon, and Bl. Michael McGivney on the right side. The candle in St. Bernadette's hand represents the discernment of one's vocation as St. Bernadette became a nun and Bl. Michael McGivney became a priest. Our Lady guides all those who are seeking God's will, especially those discerning a vocation.

In the Spring of 2022, the icon accompanied members of the U.S. military to Lourdes, France, with the *Warriors to Lourdes Pilgrimage*.

The Immacolata Icon is dedicated to all mothers, living and deceased.

# Papal Brick from the Holy Door of St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome

Knights of Columbus member, Beri Berardi, presented Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica a brick from the Holy Door, the *Porta Santa*, at St. Mary Major Basilica in Rome, on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

This brick was used to seal off the Holy Door at the close of the 2000 Jubilee Holy Year. It was blessed by Pope St. John Paul II on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 8, 2001. On December 8, 2015, it was retrieved for Pope Francis' Extraordinary Year of Mercy. It is fitting that it was presented to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica on the same feast day.

There is a Holy Door in each of the four Papal Basilicas in Rome. The Doors are sealed with bricks at the close of a Jubilee Year, a Holy Year, and removed at the beginning of a new Jubilee Year. The Holy Door symbolizes the journey towards conversion and is founded on the words of Jesus, "I am the gate: whoever enters through me will be saved." (John 10:9).

This brick is to be a sign of the affiliation our Basilica hopes to obtain with St. Mary Major Basilica in Rome.


