



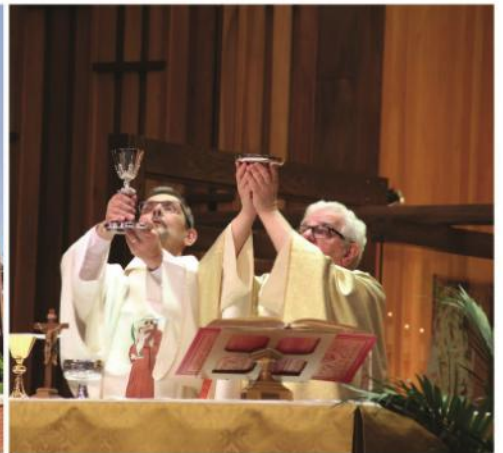

Along the WAY

I can say with the grace of God and the help of many, that as Pastor and Rector I survived the winter storm Elliott with some great memories to carry along the Way. The settings for the Christmas Masses were beautiful thanks to the careful preparations of the decorators and the florists. The sidewalks and driveways were clean and safe for the people. While the excessive cold challenged the heat at St. Anthony’s Christmas Vigil Mass the people were troopers and we prayed together with extra love, which warmed everything up. The babies who processed into Mass with their parents and who participated in the blessings of the Stable and the Christ Child were absolutely amazing. The people who participated in all our Christmas Masses were impressive in number in spite of the below zero conditions and the frigid wind. Many people who could not join us in person joined us for our live-streamed Masses, with a record number of views. Our Faith and our dedication is strong.

Of course, I ate too much and gained 6 pounds. *Mamma mia!* I am declaring an early and advanced personal Lenten Season. This is a New Year’s Resolution which should not be broken. Only time will tell.

This past week I met with workers about the transfer of the St. Lucy Outdoor Shrine from St. Lucy Church in Campbell, which closed November 2021. The Outdoor Shrine has been donated to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica. It will be carefully placed so it may be prayerfully viewed by all who pass by on Rayen Ave. I think everyone will be pleased.

The Morning Offering is now available at the Parish Offices for you if you have not yet received it. The card has on it the monthly intentions of His Holiness Pope Francis.



Today, we observe the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. The House Blessing will be blessed at each Mass for your homes for the Year of Our Lord 2023. At all the Masses we will share the annual visit of *La Befana* to the Parish. We recall the most celebrated Italian story of the elderly woman who was sweeping her floors when the three Magi interrupted her and invited her to visit the newborn King and Savior of the World. She told them thanks but no thanks. She said, “I am too busy.” Later she felt very guilty and knew she made a huge mistake. She set out to find the Magi and the Baby Jesus, but she was unable to find them. Ever since, *La Befana* makes reparation for her mistake by bringing candy and toys to all the good children of the world on the Feast of the Epiphany. To the bad boys and girls she brings coal. Once again, as in the past, *La Befana* brought the good boys and girls of the parish lots of their favorite candies.

Today, let this be for us all a year of total adoration to Jesus. Let us join the Magi in adoring our Lord and Savior, and as we continue along the Way, let us be mindful of the story of *La Befana* every time we find ourselves saying we are too busy to worship Christ.
