

My journey along the Way this past week was filled with many good things. Early in the week I took a four day trip to Florida and stayed at the home of Richard and Rosanne Sereday. The sunshine and warm weather, with lots of walking, really helped me to subside the asthma that kicked up during the winter weather we experienced last month. I pray that my asthma will remain this calm for the remainder of winter.

One of my favorite places in Key West is the Basilica of Mary, Star of the Sea, where a strong 60 or more persons attend daily Mass. It is a very nice thing to experience. I returned home on Thursday night with a slight suntan and spent Friday catching up after offering the funeral Mass for the repose of the soul of Virginia Fortunato, age 77. May she rest in the peace of the Lord.

The weekend was extra busy due to a fundraiser at St. Anthony Church for Mya Krantz, an autistic teenager who has Sanfilippo, a rare genetic condition that is a type of childhood Alzheimers. The committee served over 625 spaghetti dinners and raised over \$20,000 for Mya's family to help with their enormous expenses. Deacon Tony, together with the committee and lots of volunteers, made this all happen for Mya. The kitchen had extra sauce and meatballs left over that would serve 150 people, so George, our security man, and I brought it to the Rescue Mission.

At the very same time, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel held our own monthly Spaghetti dinner, where our volunteers served 787 dinners. Now that is Italian! Thank you volunteers for the successful event!

After all our Masses last weekend, our Youth Ministry group participated in Souper Bowl Sunday, where they collected monetary donations and non-perishable goods for the needy of the Valley. There are many needs, and we appreciate all the support we received in this collection.

Have a Souper Week! Let us see what is in store for us all as we continue along the Way.





A Reflection

When you look in the looking-glass, what you see there is something which you can influence; it moves when you move, smiles when you smile, looks grave when you look grave - in a word, it models itself on you. When you look at the sacred Host, it is just the other way round. What you see there is not something which you can influence; it is something which can influence you. You've often been told, I expect, what a striking difference there is between the ordinary food you eat, and that heavenly food which is given you in the Blessed Sacrament. When you eat ordinary food, you turn it into yourself. When you eat the Body of Christ, he turns you into himself. And in the same way, this mirror of the Blessed Sacrament works in the opposite way from the ordinary mirror. It is not for you to dictate to Jesus Christ what he is to do: you are to let him dictate to you. He is not to model himself on you, you are to model yourself on him. When you look at Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, say to him, Dear Jesus, I want to imitate you in the same way as my reflection in the looking-glass imitates me.
