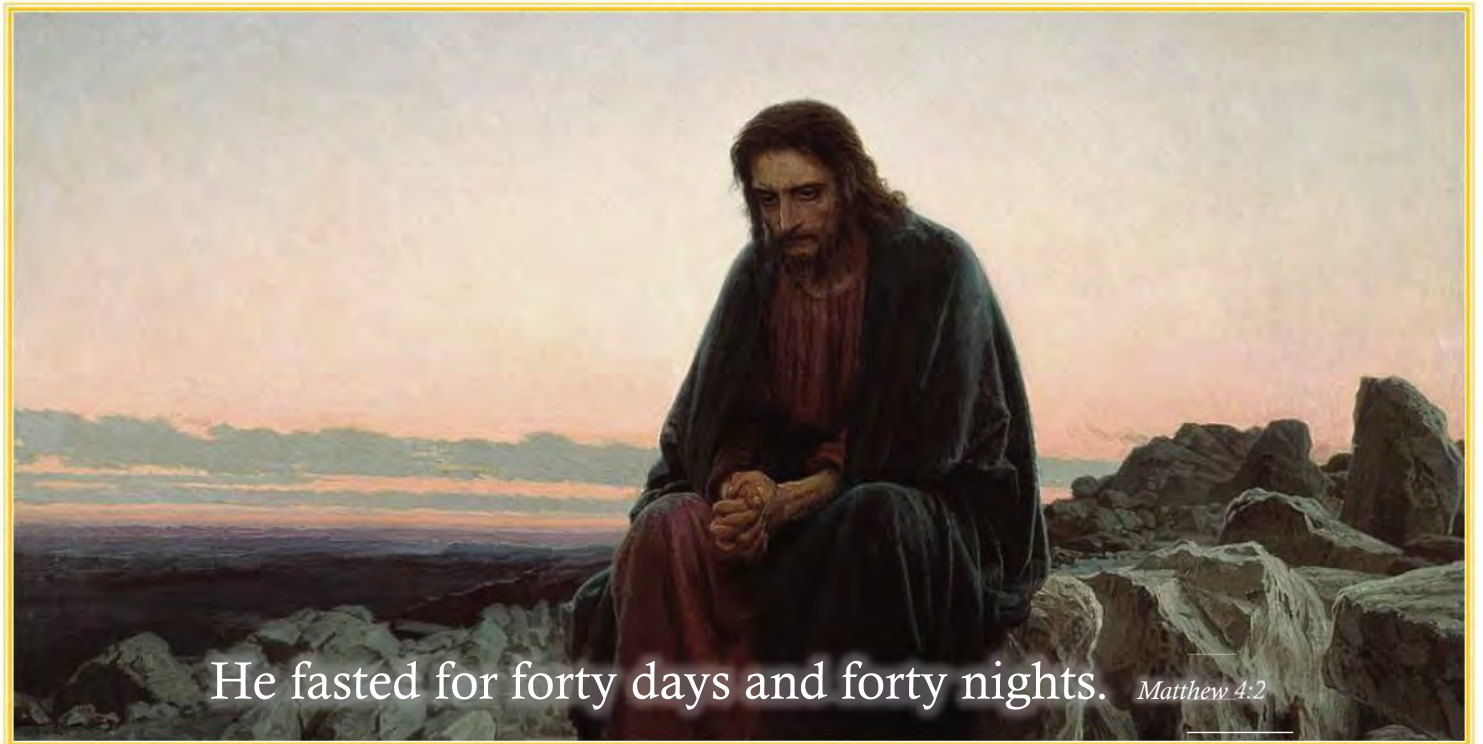

Along the WAY

This past week has been a week of preparation, planning our spiritual exercises for the Lenten Season. We now have the schedule and the preparation in place so we can effectively communicate the call to holiness this Lenten Season.

During the Lenten Season, we the faithful are called to fast (consume only one full meal and two snack sized meals) on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On all the Fridays during Lent, we abstain from meat. To assist you in your Lenten fasts, we will be featuring a favorite Lenten recipe in our bulletins. Last week, Anna Sam gave me a nice Lenten recipe to share with all who enjoy fish. This week I have a nice *pasta e fagioli* in white sauce. I will try both during this time of Lenten sacrifice.

Our parish has been assessed at \$82,900, which means I need the help of all the members of the parish so we can do our part. I thank you in advance. Please call me if you have any questions.

Excerpts from Pope Francis' Homily for Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022

Sisters and brothers, . . . our hearts thirst for eternity. Lent is the time granted us by the Lord to be renewed, to nurture our interior life and to journey towards Easter, towards the things that do not pass away, towards the reward we are to receive from the Father. . . . Prayer, charity and fasting are aids to this. . . .

Prayer, humble prayer, prayer “in secret” (Mt 6:6), in the hiddenness of our rooms, becomes the secret to making our lives flourish everywhere else. Prayer is a dialogue, warm in affection and trust, which consoles and expands our hearts. . . . let us pray above all by looking at the Crucified Lord. Let us open our hearts to the touching tenderness of God, and in his wounds place our own wounds and those of our world. Let us not be always in a rush, but find the time to stand in silence before him. . . .

If prayer is real, it necessarily bears fruit in charity. And charity sets us free from the worst form of enslavement, which is slavery to self. Lenten charity . . . brings us back to what is essential, to the deep joy to be found in giving. Almsgiving, practised far from the spotlights, fills the heart with peace and hope. . . .

Finally, fasting. Fasting . . . sets us free from the self-centred and obsessive quest of physical fitness, in order to help us to keep in shape not only our bodies but our spirit as well. Fasting makes us appreciate things for their true worth. . . . Especially in Lent, we should fast from anything that can create in us any kind of addiction. This is something each of us should reflect on, so as to fast in a way that will have an effect on our actual lives.

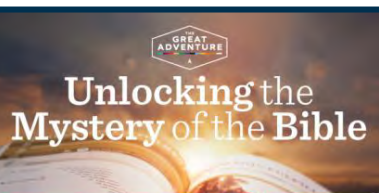

| 2 Tbsp olive oil - to start | I can Great Northern Beans |
| 4 cloves garlic | 1/2 lb ditalini pasta |
| Dash of salt & pepper to taste | Parmesan Regiano Cheese |
| Red pepper seed | |

Brown garlic in olive oil until golden. Don't burn. Add lots of black pepper and salt, and red pepper seed to taste. Add a can of beans, including liquid, and simmer together. In a separate pot, cook ditalini a la dente. Drain the pasta, reserving some of the pasta water to make the dish soupier (if desired). Add a little olive oil to the pasta, then mix the beans and the pasta together and simmer for a few minutes. Sprinkle with cheese and black pepper.

The Seven Stations



1. Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (Lk 22:39-46)
2. Jesus bound and taken before Annas (Jn 18:19-22)
3. Jesus taken before the High Priest, Caiaphas (Mt 26:63-65)
4. Jesus taken before Pilate (Jn 18:35-37)
5. Jesus taken before Herod (Lk 23:8-9, 11)
6. Jesus taken before Pilate again (Mt 27:22-26)
7. Jesus given the Crown of Thorns and led to his crucifixion (Mt 27:27-21)

A Holy Thursday Tradition that dates back to the 16th Century

After the *Mass of the Lord's Supper*, the Eucharist is transferred to the Altar of Repose. The faithful are asked to keep watch with the Lord, as the disciples were asked to keep watch with Jesus on the night before his Passion. During the Visitation, the faithful travel to seven different churches for prayer and private reflection at the Altar of Repose in each church. Each of the seven churches is the site of a different station marking the last hours of Christ's life.

St. Patrick's Day Dispensation

Bishop Bonnar has granted to the faithful of the Diocese of Youngstown, as well as to any visitor or travelers who may be physically present in the diocese, a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence from meat on Friday, March 17, 2023. **Those taking advantage of the dispensation are urged to make some other act of Lenten sacrifice of charity**, such as the public celebration of the Stations of the Cross, the giving of time in a charitable way, the spending of time in devout prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, praying for vocations, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, or the Rosary.
