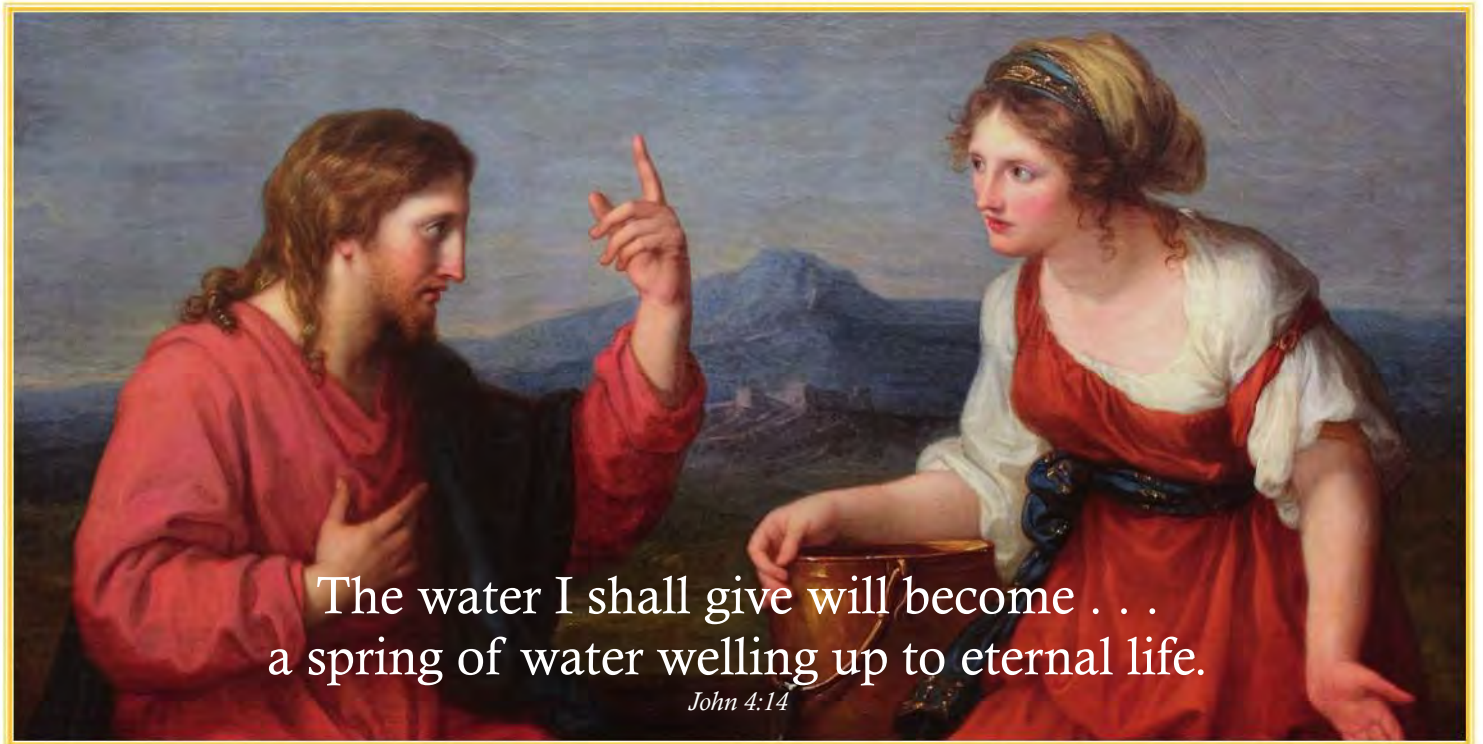

Ohio Bishops Issue Letter on Abortion Ballot Initiative

The Catholic Bishops of Ohio have issued a letter about the proposed amendment to Ohio's Constitution for the November 2023 ballot. Below is an excerpt of the letter. The full text can be viewed at <https://www.ohiocathconf.org/>.

February 23, 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

... In Ohio, the dignity of life in its earliest stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to Ohio's Constitution for the November 2023 ballot that would enshrine and expand abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. The Church must not be silent and cannot remain on the sidelines when confronted with such a clear threat to human life. This proposal demands a response, and we strongly encourage Catholics and all people of good will in Ohio to work against including the proposed amendment for the November ballot and, if it appears on the ballot, vote against the amendment to prevent countless deaths of preborn, innocent children. ...

The Catholic Conference of Ohio will be collaborating with statewide organizations, and diocesan respect life offices will be seeking volunteers to help coordinate a campaign at every parish. ...

We, the Catholic Bishops of Ohio, stand with you, our faithful, in our commitment in the name of the Lord of Life, to each human person from conception to natural death. Let us unite in fasting and offering this prayer:

God our loving Father, grant wisdom to those who govern us, compassion and courage to those who work to defend human life, and safety and care to every human being. For you alone who formed us in our mothers' wombs, and who call us home to heaven, are God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Pope Francis on the Sacrament of Confirmation

. . . We commonly speak of the sacrament of “Chrismation”, a word that signifies “anointing”. And, in effect, through the oil called “sacred Chrism” we are conformed, in the power of the Spirit, to Jesus Christ, who is the only true “anointed One”, the “Messiah”, the Holy One of God. The word “Confirmation” then reminds us that this Sacrament brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace: it unites us more firmly to Christ, it renders our bond with the Church more perfect, and it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith, ... to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of his Cross (cf. Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 1303). . . .

When we welcome the Holy Spirit into our hearts and allow him to act, Christ makes himself present in us and takes shape in our lives; through us, it will be he — Christ himself — who prays, forgives, gives hope and consolation, serves the brethren, draws close to the needy and to the least, creates community and sows peace. Think how important this is: by means of the Holy Spirit, Christ himself comes to do all this among us and for us. That is why it is important that children and young people receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Dear brothers and sisters, let us remember that we have received Confirmation! All of us! Let us remember it, first in order to thank the Lord for this gift, and then to ask him to help us to live as true Christians, to walk always with joy in the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

Favorite Meals for LENT

from our parish family

Cathy Zack's Pasta Fagioli - Red Sauce

2 Tbs olive oil	1 (14.5oz) can diced tomatoes with basil, garlic & oregano
½ white or yellow onion	½ bunch parsley finely chopped
3 cloves of garlic minced	2 (14oz) cans northern white beans
½ tsp crushed red pepper (optional)	½ lb Ditalini pasta (or any other small pasta)
1 (28oz) can plain tomato Sauce	

In a large pot heat the olive oil on medium heat. Add chopped onion and a pinch of salt. Saute until onion is translucent. Stir in garlic and red pepper flakes and cook 1 minute, stirring constantly, not to burn the garlic. Add tomato sauce, parsley and beans. Stir and reduce heat and simmer for one hour.

While sauce is cooking, cook the pasta in a large pot in slightly salted water until al dente. Once the pasta is cooked, reserve 2 to 3 cups of the water as this has so much flavor, drain the pasta and add to the tomato and bean sauce. Add ½ cup of the reserved water at a time until it is thin like a soup broth. Pour into bowl and top with grated parmesan cheese. This is great the next day.


