

Along the WAY

Last week started off with a sense of good order. On Monday, March 20, I began the week by reordering my part of the newly renovated Stewardship Offices of the parish. These consist of the Finance Office, the Comptroller's Office, and the Maintenance Supervisor's Office, which are located in the basement of the rectory at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. After more than fifty years, they really needed a restoration! All is now updated and I know the parish staff is grateful.

The rest of the week can best be described as the ongoing pastoral activity of my life. There was lots to be done but it was all very normal routine. The Stations of the Cross on Wednesday and Friday were especially awesome.

My sense of order was disrupted on Saturday afternoon, when the spring windstorm hit the Valley. I was putting the finishing touches on my homily for the Fifth Sunday of Lent, when I was informed that the roof of one of the small buildings at St. Anthony's had blown off. Then, at 3:20pm, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel experienced a power failure that affected the rectory, the Basilica, the St. John Paul II Center and the St. Vincent de Paul Food Bank. Thanks be to God, the power remained on at the Social Hall. We had a bumper crowd that night for the Vestibule Club's Night at the Races. Afterwards, I wrapped myself up in a few afghans to ward off the chill in the rectory, and used candles and flash lights to get around.

On Sunday, March 26 we celebrated together the two Masses, followed by two Baptisms at 11am, all by candlelight. And the candlelight gathering was met with great fervor. Light of Faith and Family gathered in the hall with the children and parents, completely unaffected by the power outage we were experiencing in the Basilica. During their gathering they celebrated the retirement of our Director of Religious Education, Mrs. Therese Ivanisin. In total, she has served 23 years as a Director of Religious Education, eight of them here, and many of those years in Maryland.

On Monday, Tri-Area Electric surprised me by sending an electrician to temporarily run electricity from the Social Hall to the Rectory. What a blessing it is to be in a warm house again! As I write this on Tuesday, we still do not have power in the Basilica. We continue to worship God by candlelight. In a nutshell, this past week was and still is, an adventure.

I look forward to light and heat in the Basilica soon. I get the impression that being a priest is not at all boring, as I go with all the members of the Church along the Way. Blessed Holy Week!!!



Creamy Potato Soup

- 4 large potatoes, cubed 3 Tbsp combined olive oil
- and butter I/3 cup or more onion,
- chopped small
- I stalk chopped celery
- I grated carrot 3 Tbsp flour I ¹/₂ cup milk 4 large potatoes ¹/₂ tsp garlic salt Pepper to taste


Place potatoes in a pot, cover with water and cook. Drain, reserving some potato water to thin the soup, if desired. Mash well.

While potatoes are cooking, heat olive oil and butter in a pot, saute onions, celery, carrots. Blend in the flour, then stir in milk. Simmer for a few minutes. Add mashed potatoes and season with garlic salt. Stir and simmer for 5 to 10 minutes. If too thick add reserved potato water or extra milk.
