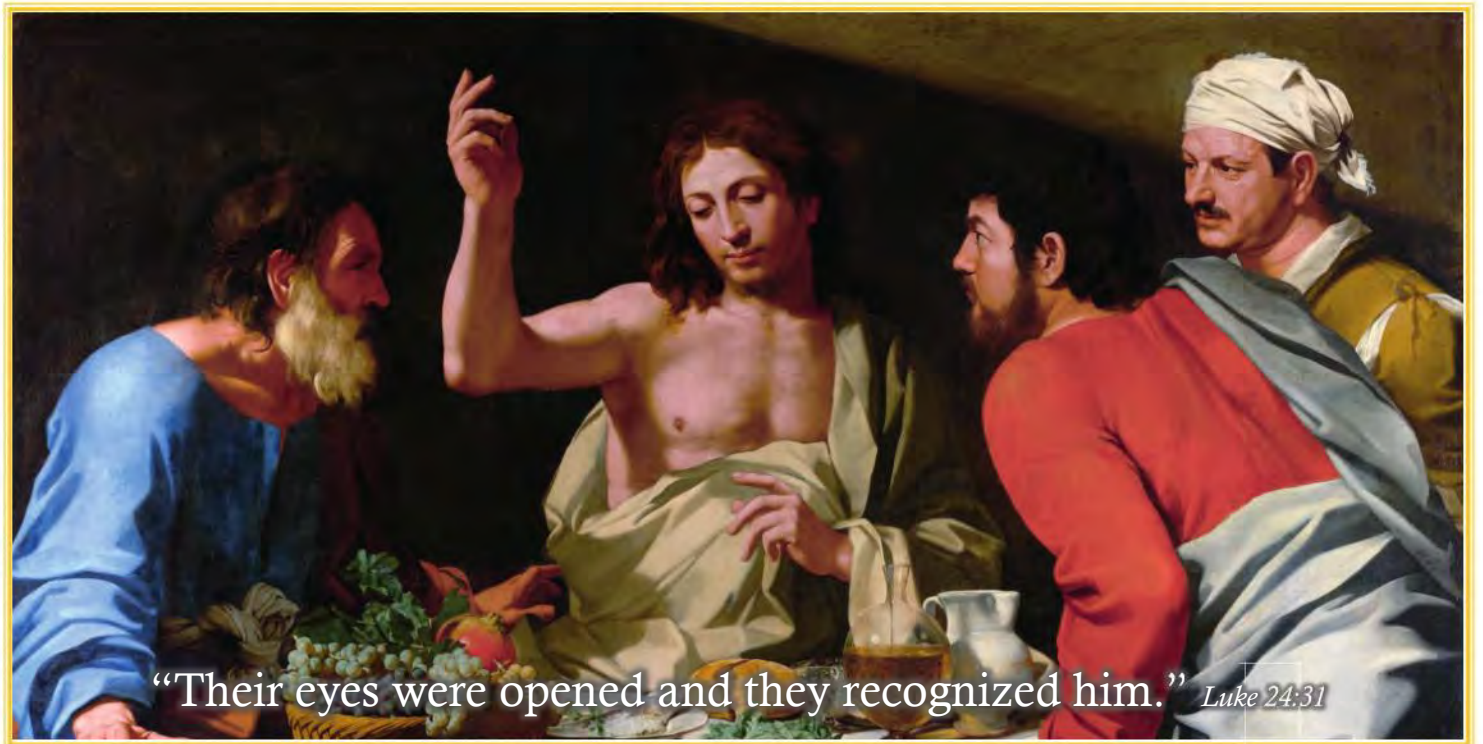

Along the Way

To everyone, I hope you had a Happy Easter and a very good Easter Octave. Christ is Risen! He is truly risen! Alleluia!! Alleluia!! Let us continue to celebrate the joy of the Resurrection throughout the Easter season, until Pentecost Sunday.

Even though I was still in the hospital, I was able to watch and be with you in prayer for the entire Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday. I received feedback from many parishioners that the Seven Church Visitation, which took place on Holy Thursday, was well received and very rewarding. The entire Easter celebration was beautiful and I thank everyone who was involved in making it so, especially Fr. Brian Smith and Fr. Anthony Okolo who celebrated the Easter Liturgies, and for Fr. Edward Gretchko, who covered for me last weekend, on April 15 & 16.

As I write this, I am presently completing acute rehabilitation at St. Elizabeth's Hospital, which should conclude on Thursday, April 20. If everything goes well, I will return to the rectory at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel on Thursday and will continue to receive outpatient physical therapy through St. Elizabeth's Rehab for six weeks in order to get me fully functioning. Several of the staff have already been trained to assist me with handling the stairs, walking, and other basic needs within the rectory.

Of course, my eyes are on the church and I want to get back to at least concelebrating Mass as soon as possible. Thank you for your continued prayers. They are appreciated and necessary.

Visitations to the rectory must be limited as I continue to recover. Should you wish to visit, I would be very happy to do so. Please arrange a visit by contacting Michele Berardi at the Parish Office: 330-743-4144.

An Excerpt from Pope Francis' General Audience on Wednesday, May 24, 2017

Jesus' encounter with the two disciples of Emmaus is a fleeting one. But the entire destiny of the Church is contained within it. It tells us that the Christian community is not enclosed within a fortified citadel, but rather journeys along its most essential environment, which is the road. And there, it encounters people with their hopes and disappointments, burdensome at times. The Church listens to everyone's stories as they emerge from the treasure chest of personal conscience, in order to then offer the Word of Life, the witness of love, a love that is faithful until the end. And thus, the hearts of people reignite with hope.

We have all had difficult moments in life, dark moments in which we walked in sadness, pensive, without horizons, with only a wall before us. And Jesus is always beside us to give us hope, to warm our hearts and to say: "Go ahead, I am with you. Go ahead". The secret of the road that leads to Emmaus is simply this: despite appearances to the contrary, we continue to be loved and God will never stop loving us. God will walk with us always, always, even in the most painful moments, even in the worst moments, even in moments of defeat. That is where the Lord is. And this is our hope. Let us go forward with this hope! Because he is beside us and walks with us. Always!

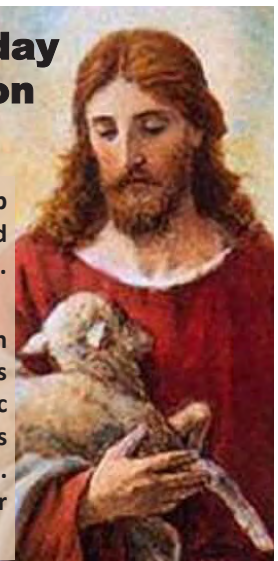

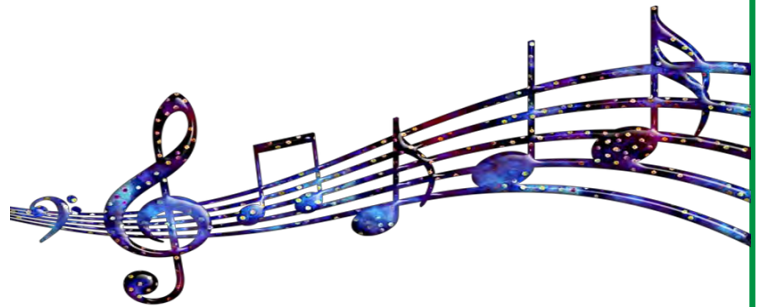
