

#### **BAPTISMS**

Infant and child baptisms take place at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica after the 11am Sunday Mass, and at St. Anthony of Padua after the 4pm Vigil Mass. Expectant parents are asked to attend a parent preparation class to help your family prepare for your child's baptism. Please call the Parish Office at 330-743-4144 to schedule the Baptism.

#### RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

#### FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information. If you are an adult wishing to receive your First Communion, please contact the Parish Office.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades. For more information please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office.

#### **ADULT CONFIRMATION**

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

#### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

After spending twenty-three days at St. Elizabeth Hospital in downtown Youngstown following my stroke, it feels very good to be home. Thank you for your prayers, delightful visits, get well cards, flowers, soups, salads, fruit, biscotti, candy, etc. Thank you for sneaking Linguini into the hospital to see me. His occasional barks got him into trouble and got him put on the hospital's most wanted list. He said it was worth it.

Over the next five weeks, I remain an outpatient at Mercy rehabilitation in order to bring back full use of the right side of my body, from head to toe. It is a slow process, but the rehab is working. I need your prayers to Our Lord, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and to St. Anthony. It was most awesome to concelebrate the Masses last weekend at St. Anthony and at the Basilica with the Dominican priests, and with you. This past Tuesday, I was the main priest at the seventh week of the St. Anthony Novena Mass since we did not have a visiting priest. It was a very special 40 minutes of life, as we go along the Way.

# Excerpts from His Holiness Pope Francis' Message for the 2023 World Day of Prayer for Vocations

This is now the sixtieth time that we are celebrating the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, established by Saint Paul VI in 1964, during the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council. This providential initiative seeks to assist the members of the People of God, as individuals and as communities, to respond to the call and mission that the Lord entrusts to each of us in today's world, amid its afflictions and its hopes, its challenges and its achievements.

This year I would ask you, in your reflection and prayer, to take as your guide the theme "Vocation: Grace and Mission". This Day is a precious opportunity for recalling with wonder that the Lord's call is grace, complete gift, and at the same time a commitment to bring the Gospel to others. We are called to a faith that bears witness, one that closely connects the life of grace, as experienced in the sacraments and ecclesial communion, to our apostolate in the world. Led by the Spirit, Christians are challenged to respond to existential peripheries and human dramas, ever conscious that the mission is God's work; it is not carried out by us alone, but always in ecclesial communion, together with our brothers and sisters, and under the guidance of the Church's pastors. For this has always been God's dream: that we should live with him in a communion of love...

Within the Church, all of us are servants, in accordance with the variety of our vocations, charisms and ministries. Our common vocation to give ourselves in love develops and finds concrete expression in the life of lay men and women, devoted to raising a family as a small domestic church and working as a leaven of the Gospel to renew the different sectors of society; in the testimony of consecrated women and men who are completely committed to God for the sake of their brothers and sisters as a prophetic sign of the kingdom of God; in ordained ministers – deacons, priests and bishops – placed at the service of preaching, prayer and fostering the communion of the holy People of God. Only in relation with all the others, does any particular vocation in the Church fully disclose its true nature and richness. Viewed in this light, the Church is a vocational "symphony", with every vocation united yet distinct, in harmony and joined together in "going forth" to radiate throughout the world the new life of the kingdom of God.

May the Virgin Mary watch over you and protect you. With my blessing.
