

BAPTISMS

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information. If you are an adult wishing to receive your First Communion, please contact the Parish Office.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades. For more information please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

Just a few news spots as we go along the Way.

Monsignor Michael J. Cariglio, Jr., Pastor and Rector

We crown thee with blossoms today, Queen of the Angels.

This weekend, at each of the Masses, children will be crowning Our Lady.

"The crowning is symbolic of Mary as Queen of Heaven and of our lives," Father John Broussard, rector of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in Champion, Wisconsin, explained to the [National Catholic] Register. "We entrust all our intentions to her, and she takes them to her Son, who is the King.



Even here at the shrine, when she appeared to Adele Brise [in 1859] at the opening of the apparitions, she said, 'I am the Queen of Heaven who prays for the conversion of sinners." 1

"We take that to heart," the priest added. "Our Blessed Mother is our Queen and our intercessor, and we symbolize that with our May crowning. Mary's queenship in the shrine is represented in the crowning of the statue."²

This weekend, we also honor *Madonna Della Libera*, Our Lady of Liberty. The people of Pratola Peligna, celebrate this Feast Day on the first Sunday of May every year. The story of the *Madonna Della Libera* is rooted in the 1500s during a cholera outbreak causing devastation and death in the Peligna Valley, in the Province of L'Aquila, in the Abruzzo region of Italy. Our Lady appeared to a poor farmer with a message of hope, to which the farmer responded 'Madonna Liberaci'! (Our Lady Deliver Us!). This invocation has been remembered and is repeated by all people from Pratola Peligna and their descendants around the world to this day.³




