RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information. If you are an adult wishing to receive your First Communion, please contact the Parish Office.

CONFIRMATION

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

This past Wednesday, the Trustees met to put a final seal of approval on our plans for Our Lady of Mt. Carmel's Italian Festival. It is looking good. I pray for a holy and successful event. Thank you, Trustees and Chair.

On Thursday, the Knights of Columbus met in significant numbers. Over the years there have been many changes to our local Council, most significantly the merger of the Immacolata Council with the Youngstown Council.
