

#### **BAPTISMS**

#### **RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS**

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

#### FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information. If you are an adult wishing to receive your First Communion, please contact the Parish Office.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades. For more information please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office.

#### **ADULT CONFIRMATION**

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. ## Reflection on *The Priority of Christ*by Bishop Barron



While strolling through the old section of Frankfurt with one of her friends, Edith Stein chanced upon the cathedral. The two women entered the building as tourists, intent upon admiring the architecture. Edith spied a woman, fresh from her rounds of shopping, kneeling in the empty church, lost in prayer. She had certainly seen people at prayer during synagogue services or around the seder table at home, or at Protestant worship, but she had never seen anything like this: "This was entirely new to me. . . . Here was someone interrupting her everyday shopping errands to come into this church, although [sic] one other person was in it, as though she were here for an intimate conversation. I could never forget that."

Silent adoration of the Eucharistic Christ would become essential to Edith's spirituality. Despite her extremely hectic teaching schedule, she would spend hours in silent prayer, kneeling motionless before the Blessed Sacrament, sometimes passing an entire night in such devotion. So impressed were the sisters by her prayerfulness that they "allowed her to place a chair off to the side of the altar, hidden from the community as well as the congregation, in the sanctuary of the church. There, tucked away behind a column, Edith could sit or kneel for hours either absorbed in the Mass or private prayer." The presence of Jesus in the Eucharist would become the organizing center of her life, the beginning and end of all her activities.

## ST. TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS (EDITH STEIN)

August 9th

St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross was born in 1891 in Breslau, Poland to a large Jewish family. She was an outstanding student, a philosopher, and a teacher. Baptized Catholic in 1922, she entered the Carmelite convent in Cologne, Germany in 1933. She was arrested by the Gestapo on Aug. 2, 1942, was sent to Auschwitz on Aug. 7, and is believed to have died in a gas chamber on Aug. 9.





#### Issue 1

Asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment."

## **Bishops' Position**

The Bishops of Ohio do not have a position on Issue 1 as it does not have moral content. However, as "responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation" (Faithful Citizenship, No. 13), the bishops urge Catholics in Ohio to register and vote in the special election.

Project Rachel - Provides confidential post-abortive healing to women and men affected by abortion


