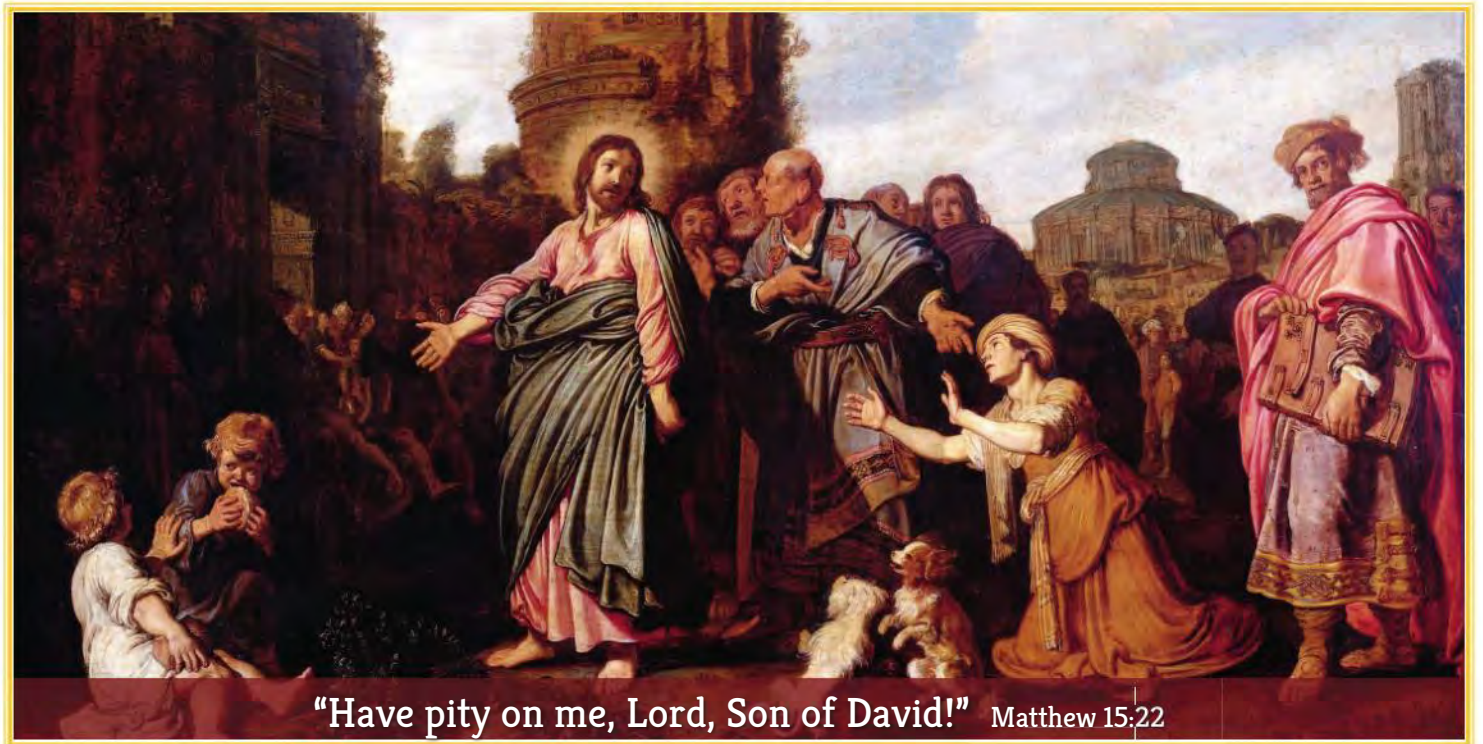

**BAPTISMS**

**RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS**

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

**FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION**

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information. If you are an adult wishing to receive your First Communion, please contact the Parish Office.

**CONFIRMATION**

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades. For more information please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office.

**ADULT CONFIRMATION**

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

## Without Adoration, There's No Evangelization

Excerpt from the August 13, 2023 edition of the National Catholic Register

The world is in desperate need of the Gospel. And the urgency of this need — underscored by decreasing religiosity and increases in depression, apathy and anger — animates any number of feverish debates about just how to evangelize the culture. What methods should we use? What tone should we strike? And what is the goal we're seeking?

But this week in Portugal, Pope Francis reminded us of an irreplaceable, foundational element that is often overlooked — or even derided — in our discussion of evangelization: the need for prayer and, especially, Eucharistic adoration.

The Pope's comments came during a homily to Portuguese clergy, religious, and pastoral workers as part of Francis' World Youth Day visit. Encouraging those gathered to overcome disappointments in ministry and to faithfully follow Christ's command to lower their nets into the sea, the Holy Father acknowledged that to do this requires more than words — "a lot of prayer is needed." . . .

"Only in adoration, only before the Lord can the taste and passion for evangelization be recovered." But curiously, "we have lost the prayer of adoration." Recovering this practice of being in silence before the Lord — so central in the lives of great saints like Mother Teresa of Calcutta and Thérèse of Lisieux, even in times of spiritual desolation — is a requirement for all Catholics, especially those devoted to sharing the Gospel.


