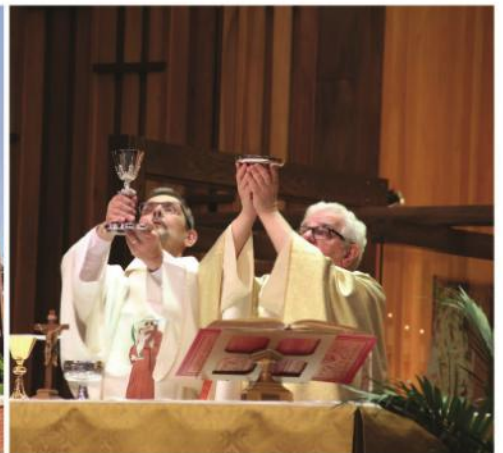

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information. If you are an adult wishing to receive your First Communion, please contact the Parish Office.

CONFIRMATION

Along the Way

This past week several talked to me about the Synod of Bishops, which recently began in Rome, under the theme, “For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission.” The Synod of Bishops began after the Second Vatican Council when over 3,000 Bishops expressed a desire to communicate frequently with the Pope about important issues that effect the life of the Church in the rapidly changing world. This is the 16th Ordinary gathering since the Second Vatican Council. There have also been other special gatherings; all of them treated timely issues in the world, such as family, youth, evangelization, etc. Good came, I am sure, out of all of them.

In preparation for this 16th session, Pope Francis wanted to hear, not only from Bishops, but the laity, religious, deacons, and priests. This has been taking place for two years and you may have accepted the invitation to be part of it. Bishop Bonnar submitted the results of our Diocese to the Pope about many concerns of our people. Now the Synod gathers and over the next year, we will see what they have to say to Pope Francis about how the Catholic Church can powerfully preach and teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the whole world for the salvation of souls. All this as we go along the WAY.

Pope’s October prayer intention: ‘For the Synod’

“Let us pray for the Church, that she may adopt listening and dialogue as a style of life at every level, allowing herself to be guided by the Holy Spirit towards the world’s peripheries.”

“Through prayer and discernment, the Holy Spirit helps us carry out the “apostolate of the ear,” that is, listening with God’s ears in order to speak with the word of God,” he said, noting that, “Thus, we draw near to the heart of Christ. Our mission and the voice that draws us to him spring from him.” Pope Francis concludes saying that “This voice reveals to us that the heart of mission is to reach out to everyone, to seek everyone, to welcome everyone, to involve everyone, without excluding anyone” and inviting all believers to pray for the Church during the Synod “that she may adopt listening and dialogue as a style of life at every level, allowing herself to be guided by the Holy Spirit towards the world’s peripheries.”

Synod on Synodality

The General Assembly of the Synod on Synodality begins on Wednesday, October 4 2023, following a two-year process that started in September 2021 when the Vatican released a preparatory document and instructions on preparing for the gathering. Hundreds of Catholics from around the world then met in their parishes to discuss the questions posed by the synod. The syntheses of those conversations were then sent to their respective Bishops’ Conferences that are tasked with bringing all voices to the table. Finally, representatives of the episcopal conferences met at the continental level, the final stage before the General Assembly, which itself will take place in two parts, beginning with the gathering in 2023 and concluding with a second meeting in October of 2024.

The Synod will see the participation of 363 voting members, including women. Some participants will be attending as representatives of Bishops’ Conferences, others have been appointed personally by Pope Francis, and some will be attending as “fraternal delegates,” “spiritual assistants,” or “experts and facilitators.”

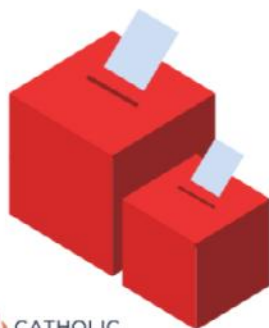
Because Your Vote Matters
