



Sacrament Information

BAPTISMS

Infant and child baptisms take place at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica after the 11am Sunday Mass, and at St. Anthony of Padua after the 4pm Vigil Mass. Please call the Parish Office at 330-743-4144 to schedule the Baptism.

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

Along the WAY

In this Season of Advent, I am very grateful for the beauty of our Advent wreaths at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony Church. These wreaths have been very carefully decorated in the spirit of Advent, and they remind us of the cry that we make as the Church during this holy season: *O Come Emmanuel, Savior of the Whole World*! As the four candles are lit during this month of preparation for Christmas, may this cry grow in our hearts.

Another beautiful symbol of Advent is the Jesse Tree. What is the Jesse Tree? The best way to put it is that it is like an ancestry.com for the Christian. Where does the Jesse Tree come from?

Firstly...who is Jesse??

Remember the story of Boaz and Ruth? One of their grandchildren was named Jesse. When Jesse grew up, he became the father of David (yep, the same David who won against Goliath!). David would grow up to become the King of Israel.



Isaiah prophesied that the Messiah would be a descendant of King David (and therefore also a descendant of Jesse). The prophet said that "there shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots" (Isaiah 11:1). Matthew 1:1-17 traces Jesus' entire family line, from Abraham all the way to Joseph...and guess what?

The prophecy was fulfilled! Jesus is the "Son of David"...and Jesse is his great-gre

What is the Jesse Tree?

In the early European Catholic Church, the visual image of Jesus' family tree became very popular. Jesus' family tree was drawn onto medieval manuscripts, embroidered onto fabric, and put into stained glass windows. Some of these images are still preserved today!

Not only is the tree a beautiful inspiration for art, but it also served as a perfect teaching tool about Salvation History (especially at a time when not everyone could read or write).

Today, the Jesse Tree has turned into a hands-on way to prepare our hearts for Christmas. By reading a passage from Scripture every day and hanging a corresponding ornament that relates to the Scripture passage, we see the big picture of God's plan to reopen the gates of Heaven.

This is known as Salvation History.


